Median household incomes in Illinois are \$65,030. In 2018, the county with the highest Median Household Income in Illinois DuPage County, IL with a value of \$93,750, followed by Kendall County, IL and Lake County, IL, with respective values of \$89,862 and \$87,133. Men in Illinois has an average income that is 1.33 times higher than the average income of women, which is \$55,889. The income inequality in Illinois (measured using the Gini index) is 0.48, which is higher than the national average. The economy of Illinois uses 6,04M people.
