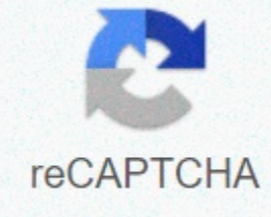

If you get a warning message on your computer that asks you to call number 833 for technical support, it's likely that your device is compromised. Do not call this 833 number. Once the phone scammer makes contact with his target, either by being called or calling himself, they will attempt to access to a computer by pretending to be a government or company employee. Area code 833 scammers who call their potential victims usually find their goals by collecting names and phone numbers from public online directories or social networks such as Facebook, Instagram, LinkedIn and Twitter. Such scammers can also deceive people into calling them by sending fake emails, text messages or direct messages that look as if they were sent from a legitimate company. Users can also be tricked into calling 833 area code numbers by online advertising or fake computer system messages created by malware. The easiest way to avoid being scammed by an 833 area code phone scammer is to just call an 833 number or never make a call back. If you've been tricked into installing a program on your device, you should immediately uninstall it, update a software on your computer or phone, and run a good virus scanner to make sure you haven't missed anything. You'll also need to change the password for every service or device that you use the password you gave the scammer. No matter what kind of phone scam you've got involved with, you should always report scammers to the appropriate parties to help them prevent others from scamming in the future. Those that have sent money to someone after falling victim to an area code 833 phone scam must contact their bank and credit card company immediately to help secure their accounts and reverse any transactions that have been made.
