It was developed in collaboration with IBM and ATI (AMD) and released in South America, North America, Japan, Europe and Australia between 2005 and 2006. The Xbox Live service (surcharge) allows players to compete online and download content such as arcade games, demos, trailers, TV shows and movies. The Xbox 360 is the direct successor to the Xbox and participated in Nintendo's Sony PlayStation 3 and Wii as part of the seventh-generation game consoles. [3] As the main technical functions, there is the central processing unit based on an IBM PowerPC and its graphics processing unit that supports Unified Shaders technology. This allows you to play continuously for about 8 hours without any problem, as it turns itself off when it detects heating and only turns it back on when it cools down. The system includes a dedicated port to add an external hard drive and is compatible with most USB connector devices thanks to the USB 2.0 ports. The accessories in this system can be used on a personal computer, such as the Xbox 360 controllers and steering wheel. Xbox 360 officially became known on MTV on May 12, 2005 and release dates were released in September of that year at the Tokyo Game Show. [4] It is the first console to provide almost simultaneous release in three major sales areas (Europe, Japan, and the United States). Since its launch in 2005, there have been five models, the last two of which, Slim and Elite, finished producing the console in 2016 after more than 10 years on the market. The console had a good market in North America, Europe and other regions of the world (with the exception of Japan). [5] As of January 2009, Microsoft had sold 39,000,000 consoles, according to official figures. [6] Premium model production is suspended on 28 August 2009, but units will continue to be sold until supplies are on. [7] On April 20, 2016, Microsoft announced the discontinuation of the game console worldwide. [10] But the online service is still present despite the same console abandonment, with online service of all available titles that included online service (including Arcade Demos and Games, some titles such as Chromehounds, Army or Two. Battlefield 2: Modern Combat, Crysis 2, EA Sports MMA, The Lord of the Rings: Conquest, The Lord of the Rings: The Battle for Middle-Earth II and WWE All Stars, among many others, have currently discontinued their online service on Xbox Live, it is now unknown when the Xbox 360's online service will end. His last known game was FIFA 19. The current console firmware released on November 12, 2019 is 2.0.17559.0, where there are minor bug fixes and improvements. [11] History Background Before entering the video game consoles market, Microsoft was only developing operating systems, Windows platform games, and Apple Macintosh PS, multimedia programs, and office applications (such as the Microsoft Office suite). The American company also produced a number of peripherals for personal computers: keyboards, mice, race flyers, gamepads, joysticks. In 1998, Microsoft worked with Sega to adapt the Windows CE operating system for the Dreamcast game console. [12] Three years later, Microsoft presents its first desktop game console, called Xbox. [13] This system was based on personal computer technology, which many video game developers used this similarity to customize a large number of games and resulted in a catalog of games appealing to the public. [14] Development Early in 2002, Microsoft began work on the successor of the Xbox console.[15] that same year Sony teamed up with Toshiba and IBM to begin developing the new processor of the PlayStation 3 console and other electronic products. The Microsoft task force assigned to the development of the Xbox 360, known as Xbox Console Design Architecture, was led by system architect Nick Baker. Nick Baker was an electronics specialist who worked on the development of the 3DO game console and also participated in a number of projects for Apple Inc.[16] On August 13, 2003, Microsoft signed the agreement with ATI to develop the Xbox 360 graphics processor. [17] Later, in 2005, Microsoft unveils the key features of ATI's graphics processor: it will support 48 shaders, which will handle the shades of color, shadow, and details of graphics objects, and the processor will have 10 MB of memory. [18] On November 3, 2003, Microsoft reveals that IBM collaborated on the development of the central editor. [19] On 25 November 2003, Microsoft signed an agreement with IBM to develop central processors. At the press conference they indicate that the processor will contain three cores and will run a speed of 3.2 GHz each. In February 2005, Microsoft's Marketing Group decided to name the console, Xbox 360, and on May 12, 2005, the MTV television network confirmed the name. The name is based on surveys Microsoft did with people, asking if the name Xbox 360, PlayStation 3 and Nintendo N5 sounded the new generation. On the other hand, Microsoft didn't want to use the name Xbox 2 because it alluded to the name PlayStation 2. [20] Presentation The Xbox 360 accompanied by the HD DVD player. On May 12, 2005, on MTV, Microsoft officially introduced the Xbox 360. [26] Later, in 2006, Xbox 360 was sold in Mexico, Colombia, South Korea, Hong Kong, Singapore, Taiwan, Australia, New Zealand, South Africa, Bolivia, Peru, India, Brazil, Poland, Czech Republic, Russia, Hungary, Slovakia, and the Philippines. In the first year on the market, the system was launched in 36 countries, more countries than any other console has released in a single year. [27] Because of its early release, the Xbox 360 takes a year's lead to rivals Sony with its PlayStation 3 and Nintendo with its Wii. On the first day of the launch of the Xbox 360 in the United States and Canada, within a few minutes the team was completely sold out in all major stores, due to the low number of units offered for sale. [28] Models The Xbox 360 Elite. Due to the high production costs of the Xbox 360, Microsoft initially decided to launch a basic model and a professional model. When hardware reviews and strong competition emerged in the market, new models appeared (such as the Xbox 360 Elite and Xbox 360 Arcade). Consoles of different colors can be found. At the end of 2005, the Xbox 360 was available in two standard variants: the Xbox 360 Premium package was priced at \$399 or \$280, and the Xbox 360 Core priced at \$299 and \$199. The original Premium version contained a small multimedia remote as in promotion. Later in 2007, the Elite Package was released with a price of US\$479. The basic Xbox 360 Core model, which was initially released on the market, will be replaced by the Xbox 360 Arcade in October 2007. [29] On March 10, 2008, Microsoft announced a general discount of all its Xbox 360 models on the European market, the discounted amount is 80 euros. [30] Commercial models The Xbox 360 Core is a basic model of the Xbox 360, released at a price of \$299 and \$299. Package includes 3m wired controller, cable a month-long trial of xbox live gold. [31] Unlike the Xbox 360 Premium, the Core has a grey DVD tray finish. In October 2007, the Xbox 360 Core was replaced by the Xbox 360 Arcade. On October 18, 2007, Microsoft announces this model publicly in the Financial Times[33] and on October 22, 2007, release dates are confirmed. [34] The Xbox 360 Premium is the second model released with the difference that this includes hard drive. Initially, this model had a central processing unit and a 90 nanometer (nm) graphics processing unit. In later revisions, the 90 nm central processor was replaced by a 65 nm processor and an HDMI port was added to this model. In the future, Microsoft plans to replace the 65 nm central processing units with about 45 nm. Since 2005, the Xbox 360 Premium has a 20GB SATA hard drive, remote control, wireless controller, Ethernet cable and finally a high-definition cable. [35] In 2008, the 20GB hard drive was replaced by a 60GB hard drive, but this measure was applied in some countries such as Mexico, Chile, Peru, Spain, the United States and the United Kingdom. With the reduction in the production costs of Xbox 360 equipment, Microsoft announced the worldwide retirement of the Premium model in August 2009. Only the Arcade and Elite model is for sale. [36] However, cumulative shares priced at \$249.99 continue to be sold in the U.S. [38] The Xbox 360 Elite is the fourth model on the Xbox 360, released on April 29, 2007, in the U.S. [39] and August 24, 2007 in Europe. [40] The package includes: 120GB SATA hard drive, HDMI cable, one month Xbox Live Gold and Silver subscription. [40] Unlike the Xbox 360 Premium, the Elite version has a black finish on the case and the wireless controller (Gamepad) that adds elegance to the console. This model is emerging as one of the first revisions to Xbox 360 hardware. The official price is US\$449.99[41] and \$369.99. [42] The Xbox 360 S is the fifth model to be released on July 16, 2010. First introduced on the 2010 E3, the main features are the 250GB hard drive (there's also 4GB), internal Wi-Fi, touch buttons, and the glossy black finish. The team is also smaller in size and less noisy compared to its predecessors. The Xbox 360 250GB replaces previous models, has improved ventilation and is turned off when it is too hot to prevent the 3 red lights from getting out[43] The Xbox 360 E was released on June 10, 2013, after giving more details about Xbox One, Microsoft decided to release it for sale, giving more time for life to the 360. These special editions are usually custom colors of Xbox 360 models, and are produced in limited numbers. At the Electronic Entertainment Expo 2007 press conference, Microsoft announced the special Halo 3 edition of the Xbox 360 console, released on September 16, 2007. [49] The outside coverage of the console has a game theme, as well as wireless headphones, and the wireless controller. The package includes a game main character headset, wireless controller, wireless headset, 20GB hard drive and HDMI port. It's priced at \$399.99 and \$279.99 (Original Xbox 360 Premium Price). [51] During the promotion of The Simpsons movie, Microsoft created a special yellow edition of the Xbox 360 console. This setting is based on the Xbox 360 Premium package, with the only difference in the color scheme of your Xbox 360 console and wireless controller. [53] Call of Duty: Modern Warfare 2 was published in a special edition with two wireless controls and the Elite edition of the video game console with logos allusive to the game. In 2010, a special edition of the new Model S was released, in a package featuring the video game Halo: Reach, headphones, two wireless controls and the console, the latter in metallic gray finish with designs alluding to the above game. To mark the release of Gears of War 3, Microsoft released in 2011 a special edition of the S model with a 320GB hard drive, with a combination of grenade and black colors, with the logo of the game. Kinect Star Wars also has its special edition for the console on the S model. In this case, the console is decorated with motifs reminiscent of the appearance of the android R2-D2 (it even emits sounds like that of the robot), while the controller is gold and with parts reminiscent of cables, mimicking the appearance of the android C-3PO and recording the Kinect in white, also the kinect Star Wars video game. [60] Kinect is a motion sensor controller for the Xbox 360. It was first unveiled on June 1, 2009 at the Electronic Entertainment Expo, under the codename, Project Natal. Kinect allows users to control and communicate with the Xbox 360 without having to use a game controller through a natural user interface using gestures, voice commands,[61] or presenting objects and images. This device is compatible with all existing Xbox 360 models. October 26, 2010 is the scheduled release date. In October 2010, the peripherals were presented in Madrid with an expected departure date of 11 November 2010. In January 2011, Microsoft released Kinect sales to more than 8,500,000 units. [62] Xbox Dashboard Software is a small operating system stored in the console's read-only memory, which is responsible for managing the console's computer content. The program's graphical interface consists of four tabs or pages, the user scrolls with the xbox 360 control pad, or with the arrows of a keyboard. Each tab manages different content, such as Xbox Live, Games, media, and system settings. The dashboard runs automatically when the console starts, only if a disc hasn't been placed in the tray before. In update 9 May 2007, MarketPlace went on to form a new tab. [63] The small keyboard added to the Xbox 360 Controller. Since the console's release, Microsoft has distributed several updates to the operating system. These updates have added new features to the console; Xbox Live improves media functionality and playback; additional support for new accessories, and fixing some bugs in the software. On January 30, 2006, the firmware had its first update where some bugs were fixed and added the option to save games when a profile is deleted. [64] In the Spring 2007 update, the Dashboard is added to the Windows Live Messenger instant messaging client program, thanks to these added users with Xbox 360 being able to chat with users using Windows and Mac OS X operating systems. [65] An important aspect of the program, the player can chat while playing a multiplayer game via Xbox Live. The program can be controlled by a USB keyboard connected to the console's USB ports or Messenger Kit, so you don't select letter by letter with the Xbox 360 controller. Also, the program can be controlled by the remote distributed in the Xbox 360 Premium or Elite version. The dashboard also has the Windows Media Center home entertainment program, it is a computer application that serves to view the contents of a personal computer on a television. The content that can be viewed are photos, music and movies. The way to use and control the program is to use the Xbox 360 media control, keyboard, or Xbox 360 controller. [66] The last update to the Dashboard was revision 2.0.6683, and was released on December 4, 2007. In May 2008, Microsoft decided to cancel the spring update to focus on improving the xbox live online service. [67] On November 19, 2008, the Xbox 360's graphical interface will be updated to replace tabs with a rotating menu similar to Windows Media Center, known as New Xbox Experience or NXE. [68] On December 6, 2011, the interface was updated with new apps, such as TV, YouTube (these last two apps require Xbox Live Gold subscription), voice and gesture control (in interface and some games) and mobile phone control with the Windows Phone operating system. [72] In June 2008, the U.S. game list totaled 464 games since the November 2007 update,[73] but there are less compatible titles on the European and Japanese market, with 295 and 101 titles, respectively. Initially, Microsoft mentioned that they plan to distribute a large number of emulators as soon as they become available, with the goal of converting the entire Xbox library to Xbox 360. Since then, they have made several statements indicating that this can never be complete, although the number of changes to the backward compatibility list continues. The community has an annual cost of US\$99/GB-65 per subscription. The program suite has had 800,000 downloads worldwide. [75] Xbox Live Main Article: Xbox Live Xbox Live is the online service created by Microsoft to support Xbox 360 multiplayer games, and Windows Vista platforms, this service has a subscription fee. This service premiered on 15 November 2002, in the US[76] and 14 March 2002 in Europe, with great success. [77] The service offers a variety of content for download such as arcade games, Xbox games, movies, music, extras (from games purchased on DVD), demos and dashboard updates. In addition to paying for the subscription for the service, the subscriber also pays for the content separately through pre-paid cards purchased in video game stores or paid for with credit cards. Regardless of the cost of the service, Xbox Live today brings together 10,000,000 users in 30 countries that communicate in nine different languages. [78] On November 6, 2006, Microsoft announced Xbox Video Marketplace, an exclusive video store for console owners. [79] In May 2008, the title Grand Theft Auto IV placed as the number one game of the most played on Xbox Live moving Call of Duty 4 and Halo 3 into second and third place respectively. [80] In January 2009, Microsoft reported 17,000,000 registered users, thanks to the Dashboard update, which integrates the New Xbox Experience interface, at the end of 2008. [81] Multimedia The official HD DVD movie player for the Xbox 360. The Xbox 360 offers multimedia features similar to the Xbox's predecessor. The console supports various optical disk formats: DVD-Video, DVD-ROM, DVD-R/WM, DVD-R/RW, DVD-R/RW, CD-DA, CD-ROM, CD-R, CD-R, Windows Media Audio, MP3 CD and JPEG Photo CD format audio discs. [55] The console has the ability to play music on CD or play movies on DVD. Music on a CD can be stored on the console's hard drive. Some audio players (iPod or Zune) can be used on your computer, thanks to their USB 2.0 ports. Another important feature of the Xbox 360, the photo content of a digital camera can be viewed on your computer. Premium and Elite packages include songs from some artists, a small video of the console design process, and Cinema. [82] Images in a storage drive (hard drive or flash drive) can be viewed on Xbox 360 and slide show collections with different transition effects. Photo content stored on servers or computers can also be played on Xbox 360 using the Windows Media Center program (a network connection is required). The Xbox 360 is supported in the WMV-video format, as well as the high definition H.264, MPEG-4, WMV, and playsForSure WMV video. The 2007 fall update adds support for mpeg-4 Part 2 Advanced Simple Profile (ASP) video format to the dashboard. At the end of 2007, a new update for the console firmware will be added, the MPEG-4 Part 2 video format playback media, which is used by Divx and Xvid. [83] Since the release of the Xbox 360, Microsoft has supported the HD DVD movie format. On November 17, 2006, the official HD DVD player for the Xbox 360 was released, the device had an initial cost of \$200 in the U.S. market, the package includes a movie, installation disc, remote control and power supply. [84] The computer has a USB connector cable that connects to the Xbox 360 USB ports. In addition, the player can be used on a personal computer, thanks to the USB connector, which allows users to play the contents of HD DVD or DVD on the PC. [85] After the commercial failure of the HD DVD format and its termination of manufacture, the HD DVD reader for Xbox 360 suffered the same fate, being discontinued sales and the last units available in stores can be purchased at a low price. Technical problems The Xbox 360 encounters the problem Circle of Death (marked by red lights) caused by overheating of the console. Some consoles may be subject to technical problems with red lights appearing on the front of the console, which appear after playing a certain amount of hours. A week after its release, a number of reports began to emerge regarding issues with the team. Reports stated that the computer works for about 15 minutes, shortly after the game image was frozen. [86] In 2006, Microsoft began receiving a large number of complaints about computer failures. Microsoft began extending the 90-day warranty to affected computers, but this measure was only implemented in certain regions such as North America (Canada and the US) and Europe. [87] One of the problems reported to Microsoft is the red lights on the front power LED console. These lights indicate that the equipment is down due to overheating. Aside from the problem of red lights, optical readers on some consoles can scratch discs with sudden movement or repositioning to the console. [88] Research conducted by the Dutch TV Checkout confirmed the reader's problems, and the researchers also claimed that some Toshiba-manufactured units are more likely to scratch discs than those manufactured by Hitachi. [89] Eventually, Microsoft launched a replacement plan for the affected discs, however, the company suffered a number of lawsuits over this issue. [90] On July 5, 2007, Microsoft announces that it will expand its overall warranty coverage for Xbox 360. This expansion only covers teams with red lights, including all equipment sold on the first day and sold in 2008. This measure includes a refund to any customer who has previously paid repair costs arising from the red light problem. [92] In February 2008, SquareTrade conducted an investigation into customers who had shipped their Xbox 360 console for warranty. They found that 171 consoles (16.4%) they were sent to the warranty for decompression, meaning that one in six consoles will have to go through technical service at some point in their lives. [94] Microsoft hardware reviews have performed a number of revisions to Xbox 360 hardware, which has brought significant benefits to the buyer, such as the disappearance of the red light problem. Among the improvements that have been made to the equipment are: the decrease in electricity consumption, the heating of the equipment, and the cost of production. Each hardware patch is named by a code name. Xenon Code is the main name of the first hardware version of the Xbox 360. This version had the first 90nm processors and the motherboard had no HDMI port. Xenon plates caused several problems for users with the dreaded red lights, indicating the overheating of the red light. Xenon would be replaced by later versions of hardware, Zephyr code and Falcon. [95] Zephyr Code is the code name for the xbox 360's first hardware overhaul, from which Xbox 360 Elite would emerge. It consisted of redesigning the motherboard, optimizing energy consumption and using better components in assembly, in addition a third heatsink was added to the GPU to improve cooling (this attachment continued to be used in the other console revisions), the HDMI port with digital output would be added to reach resolutions greater than 1080p if the 3, it was also equipped with a 120 GB hard drive meant to download multimedia content and finally the case got a black color just like the controller to give an elegance to this product. [96] Falcon Code is the main name of the Xbox 360's second hardware overhaul, on all its models. The review consisted of replacing the 90nm CPU with a 65nm CPU and eventually redesigning the motherboard. The review brought a very important benefit to the buyer, such as the reduction in the cost of the equipment and the decrease in the overheating of the equipment. This review has 2 improvements to this that include the Falcon V2 which consists of integrating 6 capacitors and improving the memories from 64 mb each to 128 mb each, which generates less heat. The Falcon V3 contains 8 capacitors, the same memories as the V2 and also the capacitors go from electrolytic to solid, so they can withstand high temperatures, this is a much cooler and more reliable console. [97] Jasper Code is the main name of the current Xbox 360 review. The Jasper model was released in October 2008. The main innovations are the use of a revamped 65 nm graphics processing unit, an element that could not be included in the Falcon model. Some believe that having the Xbox 360 65nm GPU completely eradicated computer overheating. However, Microsoft has said that you don't have to wait for this review to buy a safe Xbox 360 because the Falcon model doesn't have overheating issues.
