Much of this speaks to how to avoid cheating on the part of the dealer, which is unlikely to happen in the modern era in the biggest casinos. This is another section you may miss. Section 5 discusses the game of smart games, as well as talks about the dealer's reading. Much of this is fluff, but it's still fun to read and considerably more relevant than the previous few sections. Whether dealers can actually read effectively or not is the story for another day, but the author seems to think so and lays his strategy open to us in this book. The sixth section provides one of the best tutorials on blackjack strategy that you'll find anywhere. Instead of just offering a large chart to remember, Humble organizes a basic strategy in several charts based on the type of hand you've dealt with. It breaks it into manageable pieces, making it easy to read, easy to understand and easy to implement. Section 7 explains the Hi-Opt I card counting system, which guides you on how to implement it correctly. It also includes information on how the size of your bets are based on the account. This is one of the best sections in the book, and certainly one of the most valuable. This system is discussed in more detail in section 8, which also shows how to optimize your profit when using this system. These are the two parts that makes the book, there's no doubt about it, and it's these two sections that make it one of the best books out there. There are still some tips on the system in section ten, while Section Nine talks about home blackjack games. There are two more sections after that, but they are just more filler and can be ignored.
