## Programming cablevision remote control

Place the key in the ignition of the car and turn the key to the on position. Tap and hold the switch program on your car's alarm transmitter. Click any button on the remote control of the car while you hold the switch program and release both buttons. Click on the Program to turn on the Viper alarm transmitter again and release it. Remove the key from the ignition and click on the Viper remote to see if the programming is working. Michael E Carpenter Adelpia remote control is commonly used with Time Warner cable box sets. They can be easily programmed to control a wide range of home electronics. Television, VCR and DVD players can be controlled via a universal remote control. The remote control comes with the user's manual, which is very important to have access to when programming a remote control. Each TV has its own unique code that must be introduced for television and remote control to connect to each other. Find make your TV in the user's guide that came with the Adelpia remote control. The code will be three to four digits long. Many TV manufacturers will have multiple codes. Turn on the TV. Take the remote control and, without facing the TV, hold the TV buttons and choose at the same time until the red light flashes twice on the remote control. Enter a three- or four-digit code. If correct, the red light should flash twice. If this is not the case, enter the following code listed for the manufacturer. Check the remote control. Turn to your TV and try to adjust the volume or channel. Also check if the remote switches off the TV and back with the power button. According to Megan Ellis Panasonic universal remote allows you to work and control many of your electronic devices, but first you have to program it with each individual device. Turn off the electronic device you're planning to use with the remote control. Find the Action and Power buttons on the keyboard. The buttons are both gray. The Power button should be located in the top left corner of the remote control. The Action button should be located in the center of the remote control on the right side. Click and Power and Action buttons at the same time for about 3-10 seconds. Find the device buttons, which should be the top square of the buttons on the right side of the remote control. Click the component button that describes the device you want to program. The key is the code maker in the keyboard of your remote control if you have immediate access to the code. Enter the manufacturer's three-digit code channel keyboard on the remote control. If your record has been entered correctly, the device will be in effect. If this method doesn't work, you also have the option of placing the manufacturer's code manually. Do Code Search if you don't know or don't have access to the manufacturer's code. This process will allow you to scroll through codes that are pre-loaded into the remote control components. Find the Volume buttons that should be in the shape of the arrows. Tap the right hand to move forward through each code, and press the left arrow if you decide to view the previous component code. When you complete the code generation process, click the Power button to test the electronic device. When the screen is turned on, it will be your sign that the programming process has been successful. William Pullman Some of the remotes supplied with Samsung TVs are a universal remote control, which means they can be programmed to work with other devices in your entertainment center and reduce the amount of remote control needed to operate your devices. If Samsung's remote control has a Mode or Set button, it's a universal remote control. You can program the remote control for the DVD player, cable box, satellite receiver and VCR. Turn off the power on the device you want the program to work with the remote control. Use the Mode button on the remote to highlight the device you want to program. For example, if you want to program a DVD player, click Mode until the light goes under the DVD. If the remote control has separate buttons for each device, press the button with the correct label. Click set on the remote control and enter the first three-digit code for the device manufacturer (contained in the Owner's Guide Resources section). The code list is divided by the manufacturer. Click the Power button on the remote to turn on the device. Repeat steps from 1 to 4 using the next code in the list if the device doesn't turn on when you press the Power button. Continue to view the list of codes until the remote control can control the device. David Becker/Getty Images News/Getty Images Programming a Toshiba remote control requires access to a table of remote control codes found in the owner's manual or user manual for the Toshiba device. Although many Toshiba remotes include a search feature that automatically links the device to the proper code, the function does not work with TV brands. If the device's manual is not available, browse the Internet for the appropriate Toshiba remote control code. After receiving a Toshiba list of remote control codes, turn on the TV, DVD player or other device that should be connected to the Toshiba remote control. Open the user's manual for the Toshiba remote control, and The device code table. Find a section for the type of device that needs programming. Find the manufacturer's name for a device that needs programming. Keep the code number next to the manufacturer's name. The first code is the most common code and usually works for the appropriate brand produced by the manufacturer. Tap the Mode button on the Toshiba remote until the light indicator appears next to the type of device that needs programming. Then press and hold the Recall button on the Toshiba console. Holding the Recall button, enter the first four-digit code listed in the device code table. Once the code is entered, the Mode light will blink twice. If the light only flashes once, pass the code and re-enter it. If the code is valid, the remote control will start working instantly. If the remote control doesn't work, move to the next code in the device code table and repeat the same steps until the remote is activated. Activated.
