Show me a man who's not in some way a narcissist, and I haven't seen anything fraudulent about what he preaches. Despite his personal wealth, the size of his congregation and his influence in Charlotte, he is very normal. Some days he wears a button with his pants. Next week he will wear a Charlotte Hornets t-shirt and a matching Jordan (he really does wear that). The way he preaches, his behavior. He's not like other preachers who act like royalty in the church. It has a very down-to-earth quality which is almost unusual. And it comes across in this book. He is not afraid to admit his own sin or admit his own struggles. Several stories he shared shocked me because he is a pastor and you don't expect your pastor to stumble or have problems. You expect your pastor to give you advice and comfort, you don't expect him to understand or empathize. The author is not someone who mastered the subject of his book, but still learns how to go, still learns to distinguish between the voice of the enemy and the voice of God, and it is reassuring not only because he is my pastor, but he is a human being I'm still fighting battle after battle. His approach is direct, shameless and a little hilarious. He's himself. That's what I can say. But this is a modern subject perfect for a generation raised on Facebook, Twitter, and Instagram. When a chatterbox says you're not, God says, I am. Pastor Steve reminds us what God's word says about himself and us and the promises he has placed before us and how to hear his voice above all others. Basically, it's the perfect book for those whose biggest enemies are themselves. I'm not big on non-fiction or Christian self-fiction, but this book sounds like it's sitting in front of you having a conversation, but at the same time it's well-written. It's deep but simple enough to get my attention and feed me with new knowledge. The central theme is hope. How to keep it, how to build it and how to use it as a weapon.
