Btoom season 2

The 1959 baseball season featured several hits - and nonaccomplishments - of note. Ted Williams reached just .254 and Stan Musial dropped to .255 in the twilight of his extraordinary runs. Harvey Haddix of the Pirates threw a perfect 12-inning game only to lose in the 13th, and teammate Roy Face was 18-1 in relief. The Dodgers returned to the thick of it after finishing seventh in 1958 and winning the National League. But the biggest surprise of all in 1959 was delivered by the Yankees. The Bronx Bombers, winners of nine American League flags in ten years, came in last place on May 20. New York's pitching problems weighed on the team and he was never able to join the race, which the White Sox eventually won by 5 games over the Indians. Detroit came fourth despite efforts from Harvey Kuenn and Al Kaline, the two wrestling best men with .353 and .327 averages. Boston and Jackie Jensen, the RBI leader at 112, came in fifth. The ERA champion was unable to do so on his own, as Hoyt Wilhelm (a mark of 2.19) and Baltimore finished sixth. Harmon Killebrew's league-leading 42 domestic runs were for naught as Washington finished last. The National League pennant race was much more dramatic. San Francisco seemed to have the flag closed with a 2-game lead over the Dodgers and Braves and a week to play. The Dodgers entered the city and swept San Francisco in three games. The Giants never recovered, dropping four of their last five to the Cubs and Cards. San Fran came in third, despite the great years of Willie Mays (.313 average, 34 homers, and 104 RBIs) and Orlando Cepeda (.317 average, 27 homers, and 105 RBIs) and a solid performance by Sam Jones (who posted the league's best ERA at 2.82 and tied with Milwaukee's Warren Spahn and Lew Burdette for the lead with 21 wins). The Dodgers and Braves finished tied for first as both teams won last Sunday. In a best-of-three playoff series, the Dodgers swept Eddie Mathews (who led the league with 46 homers), Hank Aaron (who threw 39 and led the circuit with a .355 average), and the rest of the Braves. Los Angeles boasted a balanced attack that combined experience and youth. Duke Snider and Gil Hodges combined for 48 homers, while former Cardinal Wally Moon hit .302. Speedy Maury Wills took over shortstop, and Don Drysdale, 23, won 17 games to anchor the pitching staff. Ernie Banks won his second-straight MVP with 45 homers (second on the circuit) and 143 RBIs (league tops) for the fifth-place Cubs. His American League MVP counterpart, Nellie Fox, The White Sox to a first place with their average of 306 beats. The Go-Go Sox also featured catcher Sherm Lollar (22 homers, 84 RBIs) and shortstop Luis Aparicio (the stolen base leader with 56). Cy Young Early Award winner Wynn, 39, went 22-10, while Bob Shaw went 18-6 to stabilize the starting pitching. Gerry Staley and Turk Turk were solid outside the pen. In the first game of the 1959 World Series, Ted Kluszewski conceded a pair of two-run homers to lead Chicago to an 11-0 victory over Los Angeles. The Dodgers came back behind Johnny Podres, taking the game two 4-3 and sending a 1959 World Series tie to Los Angeles. Although the Sox stroked 12 hits in game three, they lost to Los Angeles 3-1. The Dodgers then took the game four 5-4 in Hodges' eighth inning at home. A record crowd of 92,706 showed up at the Coliseum the next day in hopes of seeing out California's first World Series winner, but Chicago spoiled the game with a 1-0 victory. The Dodgers then took the game six 9-3 to Chicago for their first of many World Series crowns. It turns out that earth's elliptic orbit has little effect on the seasons. On the other hand, it is the inclination of 23.45 degrees of the rotating axis of the planet that makes us have winter and summer. The diagram below demonstrates what happens. In this diagram, you can see the rotation axis and equator. The northern hemisphere (at the top) is currently experiencing winter, and the southern hemisphere is experiencing summer. By looking at how sunlight is landing on the planet in the diagram, you can clearly see two things: The southern hemisphere is getting about three times as much sunlight as the northern hemisphere. The North Pole is getting zero sunlight, so it experiences 24 hours of darkness in January. This big difference in the amount of sunlight coming ashore in different hemispheres is what causes the seasons. Here are some interesting links: How do sundries work What causes the ice age? You can't make a joke that someone, somewhere, won't find it offensive, so you shouldn't try, the comedian explained. I thought, that's perfect. I can create a character who can say all the things that educated people are afraid to say; He has nothing to lose. In addition to Gervais, the cast of After Life includes Kerry Godliman, Ashley Jensen, Roisin Conaty, Diane Morgan, Tony Way and Mandeep Dhillon, among others.
