Real f4u corsair for sale

(photo by Rob Fox) The Vought F4U Corsair is undoubtedly one of the most powerful and charismatic fighter jets to emerge from World War II. With its unconventional and invested gull wing profile and dirty good looks, not to mention its legendary achievements, it's no surprise that the guy has captured the imagination of so many aviation-minded people. The aircraft is complexly manufactured, however, with its construction largely welded to the ground and all-but impossible to re-manufacture main spar. However, the Corsair has been experiencing a renaissance of sorts in recent years, with the restorations of several projects previously considered impossible to complete. Still, Corsairs rarely go on sale on the open market, and command significant attention when they do. Another perfect view of the Corsair in flight over an estuary in Australia. (photo by Rob Fox) As it happens, one of our sponsors now has a superbly restored example available to the demanding collector. Platinum Fighter Sales recently listed Graham Hosking's former Honduran Air Force F4U-5N for sale in Tyabb, Australia. Nobby Bartsch restored this fighter for Hosking to his current pristine condition at his shop, Aerotec, in Darwin, Australia over a period of seventeen years. Currently residing in the Australian Civil Registry as VH-III, this Corsair is a night hunting variant. He shot chance-Vought's production line in Dallas, Texas during 1951 under a U.S. Navy contract. This Corsair was one of twenty examples that the Fuerza Aérea Hondurña, the Honduran Air Force, acquired through several avenues in the mid-1950s. The Honduran government broke away from its Corsairs in the late 1970s, although they retained an example, F4U-5N Bu124715/FAH609, for historical purposes. This is the aircraft in which Major Soto Henriquezcapaped two F-51 Mustangs and an FG-1D Corsair during combat against El Salvador on July 17, 1969 - the last time piston-engined fighters fought each other in the sky. The Hondurans sold the rest of their Corsairs as a working lot to Hollywood Wings of Long Beach, California during 1978. Seven of these Corsairs were complete, and in good condition to fly under their own steam back to the U.S. (only), while dismantled components of ten more examples made the rail trip.
