

In early 1998, before its opening, the school's name triggered some controversy, as letters from community members indicated a preference for a more generic name. Michael Krop, a 1930s-born orthodontist who was first elected to the Miami-Dade School Board in 1980. Krop retired from the Board in 2004, after 24 years of service. Former board members Janet McAliley and Betsy Kaplan accused Michael Krop of pushing for the school to be appointed on separate occasions, a charge Krop denied.
