Krop Senior High School is a high school located at 1410 County Line Road in the Ives Estates area of Uninocorporated north Miami Dade County (direction Miami), Florida, USA. However, it serves the cities of Aventura, Sunny Isles Beach, the northern strips of North Miami Beach, and the unincorporated areas around the school such as Ives Estates and Ojus; its director is Matthew J. Welker. The school is located on the Miami-Dade side of the Miami-Dade-Broward County line and is the northernmost high

school in the district. Krop is considered a magnet school because it has a Repertory of Arts (STAR) Training Students program. This magnet program is a visual and performing arts program that is open to students in the Miami metropolitan area. The school's athletic rival is North Miami Beach Senior High School. HistoryBuilt in a former landfill, construction of Dr. Michael M. Krop High School began in 1996 after the Miami-Dade School Board approved plans to build a new high school in North Miami-Dade County to reduce overcrowding in local elementary and high schools, including North Miami Beach High School. Opening in 1998, Krop began with grades 9 and 10 and eventually added 11th and 12th grade; his first graduation class was the class of 2001. At the time of his opening, Krop had 1,475 students. In early 1998, before its opening, the school's name triggered some controversy, as letters from community members indicated a preference for a more generic name. Michael Krop High High it is named after Dr. Michael M. Krop, a 1930s-born orthodontist who was first elected to the Miami-Dade School Board in 1980. Krop retired from the Board in 2004, after 24 years of service. Former board members Janet McAlley and Betsy Kaplan accused Michael Krop of pushing for the school to be appointed on separate occasions, a charge Krop denied. February 17, 1998: Aventura City Council, Florida issued a resolution urging the Miami-Dade County School Board to name the new high school in Northeast Miami-Dade County Dr. Michael M.
