## Rowan university map james hall

Printable Maps To see a list of all locations by category, click the menu icon on the map on the right to get directions to the office, click the map marker. In the open menu, click the directions icon. Glasboro Campus Direction Rowan University is located in Glasboro, a town in southern New Jersey, 18 miles southeast of Philadelphia. The campus is easily accessible from the N.J. Turnpike, the Atlantic City Expressway and the Delaware River Bridge. Welcome Gate is located at 1 Memorial Circle, Glasboro, NJ 08028. From the north (northern New Jersey, New York, etc.) exit 4 (73 north) south of the NJ Turnpike. Head south on I-295 for about a mile. Follow I-295 to Route 42 (Atlantic City) to the south. Go south on Route 42 to the south of Route 55. Follow Rte.55 South to leave 50A (Glasboro Marika Hill). Take Route 322 east (2 miles) to campus. After crossing the tracks, enter the second gate at the Welcome Gate, 1 Memorial Circle. Security guards will tell you to park during normal business hours. If there are no guards, call 856-256-4922 for assistance. Take the Walt Whitman or Benjamin Franklin Bridge from Philadelphia and head south on I-676 toward Atlantic City. Immediately after I-676 enters the south of Route 42, head south on Route 55. Go south at 55 and leave 50A (Glasboro Murica Hill). Take Route 322 east (2 miles) to campus. After crossing the tracks, enter the second gate at the Welcome Gate, 1 Memorial Circle. Security guards will tell you to park during normal business hours. If there are no guards, call 856-256-4922 for assistance. Take I-95 from the west to the Commodore at Barry Bridge. Take Route 322 (15 miles) to campus. After crossing the tracks, enter the second gate at the Welcome Gate, 1 Memorial Circle. Security guards will tell you to park during normal business hours. If there are no guards, call 856-256-4922 for assistance. Take Hwy 70 west of central New Jersey to I-295 south. Follow I-295 to South Line 42 (Atlantic City). Go south on Route 42 to the south of Route 55. Take Route 55 south and leave 50A (Glasboro-Murica Hill). Take Route 322 east (2 miles) to campus. After crossing the tracks, enter the second gate at the Welcome Gate, 1 Memorial Circle. Security guards will tell you to park during normal business hours. If there are no guards, call 856-256-4922 for assistance. From the east, from the Garden State Parkway to the Atlantic City Expressway. Take the highway west to Exit 38 (Williamstown). After you leave, turn left and follow Route 322 West (8 miles) to campus. After the roundabout on Rowan Boulevard, put the first left at the Welcome Gate, 1 Memorial Circle. Security guards will tell you to park during normal business hours. If there are no guards, call 856-256-4922 for assistance. From(Maryland, Delaware, etc.) Take I-95 north to the Delaware Memorial Bridge. Take the N.J. Turnpike North to Exit 2 and continue east on Route 322. Stay at Rt.322 for about 14 miles. After crossing the tracks, enter the second gate at the Welcome Gate, 1 Memorial Circle. Security guards will tell you to park during normal business hours. If there are no guards, call 856-256-4922 for assistance. \*Please note: The tour departs from Savitz Hall (building #1) and the open house departs from Esby (#5の建物) on the map above. 322 After crossing the tracks from the west, put the second gate in the welcome gate, 1 Memorial Circle. . . the guard will tell you to park during normal business hours. If there are no guards, call 856-256-4922 for assistance. Savitz Hall is across the street on the left. After passing the large Rowan sign from 322 east to left, put the first left in the welcome gate and 1 memorial circle. Security guards will tell you to park during normal business hours. If there are no guards, call 856-256-4922 for assistance. Savitz Hall is across the street on the right. If you're a student on campus, you tend to walk past the building every day. Have you thought about what those buildings are? Below are 10 buildings you should know at Rowan University. 1. Camden Academic Building Address: Glasboro, NJ 08028 This building was originally built to house a demonstration elementary school for campuses. Students can find Rowan Radio and Rowan TV studios, classrooms, movie editing spaces, and computer labs with state-of-the-art programming and equipment. 2. Wilson Hall Address: Glasboro, NJ 08028 This is home to the University of the Performing Arts. Wilson Hall houses the dean of the College of Fine Arts, a large rehearsal space, void recital hall, practice room for individuals and groups, classrooms, student lounge, music library.3. Westby Hall Address: Glasboro, NJ 08028 This building is home to Westby Hall and houses an art studio for students interested in ceramics, sculpture, jewelry, metal making, painting, photography and prints. There are also computer labs, classrooms and auditoriums. 4. Science Hall Address: Glasboro, NJ 08028 This building is home to the Science Hall, which houses the 16-inch telescope, the Institute of Education and the 102-seat Edelman Planetarium, a rooftop observatory that houses numerous laboratories. 5. Robinson Hall Address: Glasboro, NJ 08028 Robinson HallA building located in the center of the campus. It is the largest classroom building on campus. It consists of classrooms, auditoriums and seminar rooms. There is also a small café where students can go. 6. Memorial Address: Glasboro, NJ 08028 This building is home to a memorial hall and there are many dance studios for dance rehearsals and classes. You can also view information and computer resources such as help desks, Web services, and replication centers. 7. James Hall Address: Glasboro, NJ 08028 This building is home to the College of Education, which was first named after Dr. Herman D. James Hall, who was the university's fifth president. 8. Esby Gym Address: Glasboro, NJ 08028 This building is home to Esbya Gym, short for Esbjörnsson Gymnasium. This facility has a number of classrooms for the Health and Exercise Sciences Department, faculty offices, secondary pools and especially gyms dedicated to student athletes and rowan swim teams. 9. Cooper School of Medicine Address: Glassboro, NJ 08028 This six-story building is home to a number of learning spaces for students to use, including an active learning room, an auditorium that can accommodate up to 250 people, wellness facilities, learning commons, classrooms and the university's medical library. 10. Campbell Library Address: Glasboro, NJ 08028 It is home to academic life and has a Campbell Library with more than 400,000 books. This six-story building features the RCA Heritage Museum, university archives, special collections, computers, printing, research areas and writing centers. Rowan University is a public research university with more than 19,000 students on and off campus. This university is located in Glasboro, New Jersey, and advertising in New Jersey also has a medical campus in Str stratford, where students can pursue a number of degrees and programs here.
