There is a Reading section that contains 53 questions that are urea for 64 minutes. The Mathematics section consists of 36 questions that are on time for 54 minutes. The Science section of the TEAS exam has 53 questions and is urea for 63 minutes. Finally, the Use of English and Language section has 28 questions that are 28 minutes long. What is the composite score of the TEAS test? The composite score for the TEAS test is your main score. This score is a combination of how you did on the four sections of the TEAS test. Each school has different admission criteria when it comes to your score, but most schools require your composite score to be at least 60% to 70%. How long are the TEAS test results good? The results for the TEAS test are valid for 24 months after passing the exam. Can you use a TEAS calculator? Calculators are allowed to be used during the TEAS exam. However, calculators will be provided for use. If you take the online version of the TEAS exam, the calculator will be a digital version on the computer. Is the TEAS test a multiple choice? The TEAS test consists of all multiple-choice questions. There are 170 multiple-choice questions in total on the

TEAS test. However, your score will only be measured on 150 questions, while the other 20 are examples of questions. You will not know what questions are noted and which are examples of questions. Can I go back to a question about the TEAS test? Yes, you can go back to a question you've completed or ignored, but only in your current section. How long should you take TEAS? The TEAS exam is 209 minutes long and contains only 170 multiple-choice questions. There is a 10-minute break after the second section which is not considered part of the 209 minutes allocated for the test. Can you take over the TEAS? If you did not have the score you expected on the TEAS test, you are allowed to retake the exam. If you want to take the TEAS test again, you may need to 30 days before you test yourself again, depending on the school you attend. Some nursing schools will allow you to retake the TEAS test twice, while other nursing schools may allow you to retake the test several times. I bought this book under my mother's amazon account, so I post this as a 22 year old who had to pass the ATI TEAS test for entry into nursing programs. Overall, I think this book worked well. The reading, math and English sections prepared me very well for the test. Compared to the test, the scientific section of the book was good. I felt like I had received a few questions about the test that the scientific section addressed, but did not dive very deeply into (especially with regard to the endocrine system), but the majority of scientific questions could be answered by reading and studying the book. I like that the book gave 3 practice tests. I tested myself before I started studying and after reading the book. The wording of the question and the types of questions in this book were very similar to the actual test so I thought it was a plus. Also the actual test could have been easier than the practice tests. On the three practice tests of the book, I got 80%-85%, but on the actual test, I got a 91%. I do not know to what extent my previous studies have played a role in my ability to do well on trial. I recently graduated from college with a health-related degree, but I think without this study guide I wouldn't have done as well, it helped me refresh the subjects I had forgotten as well as teach me things I never knew (mainly with regard to the English grammar section). I've probably studied over a 2 week period on and off, but if you haven't been to school or taken class in a while (especially if science isn't your strong suit) I definitely recommend using this book and studying well in advance. Compared to the price of other books, this one is a good deal for the way it prepares you. I wrote this long review because when I was looking for a book to study with there weren't many detailed reviews or many books to choose from because this version of the test is so new (they started giving it this year in August). I wanted to be useful to the next person like me. I hope it helps! TEAS Study Guide - MaxTEAS Study Guide - CustomerYesterday, I took my TEAS test after using this guide for about three weeks, and I'm happy to have won an 88% with a percentile national ranking of 97. First of all, let me say that I recommend what others in the comments say as well. Take a practice test first and see where you stand. Then use the rest of the material to practice what you missed. So let me give you all a quick breakdown of the sections of this book. Reading: The reading part is very general and is something I would recommend studying and practicing to use only the practice tests in the back. The reading questions about the TEAS test and in this book are very similar. Focus on the author's goal/tone. And always be able to identify the type of writing as a narrative or an exhibition work. Expository. The questions proposed in this book are a little more difficult than those offered during the TEAS test. I felt that this book prepared me very well for this section [I scored a 100% c.]. Some things I found important to remember are conversion units for metric (the TEAS test offered some of the conversions, but don't rely on them being there) and the rules for multiplying and dividing fractions. Since the statistics are tested, albeit very slightly, I recommend you study regression graphs and lessons for positive/negative bias. Science: This is by far the most difficult section on the actual test. Students should properly review their grades at the same time as this book. The book focuses heavily on anatomy and the biological process, as well as very basic chemistry. Some of the topics I would recommend to students to re-evaluate are: the components and anatomy of eukaryotes/prokaryotes, ion and covalent links, mitosis and meiosis products, and DNA replication. English: the English section is not as difficult as the other sections, but when you are ranked on 24 issues, it is imperative that you do well and score as many points as possible. Test the words, prefixes and suffixes most often misspelled with flash cards. Also know how to find the implicit definition of a word using context. The book really helped me the most when it came to subject-verb chords and pronoun-antecedents. In conclusion, this is a wonderful guide that will tear and plumb your brain for all the information you should have learned up to this point. It is very short and to the point compared to other available study guides. Definitely consider taking the official ITA test guide, especially if you are still completing your pre-requisite courses. But if you are normally a skilled student with your finished prerequisites who wants a very simple exam, I highly recommend this guide on the rest. I studied with this book for less than 10 days (I didn't even study every day), and I took my test this morning. This is my short version - I'll explain why the book is so effective below: VERSION LONGUE I myself am a college instructor, and so I like to think I know what methods are effective when it comes to preparing tests and studies. This book is designed to help you pass the TEAS test - not just memorize the material - which is why it is so effective. About half of the book is teaching materials, and the other half are practice tests. Their explanations on the subjects are simple, clear and understandable. They include video links and most of their videos are just as clear - they have hired decent instructors. The real brilliant, aspect of the book is the way the practice tests are formatted. They clearly describe how many questions will be on the test and how long you have, allowing you to dry run the test. Their answer key not only gives you the right answer, but also an explanation - which saves you from having to return all the way back to the material to find the reason you missed a question - you learn every time you use the book. Mometrix really thought about it. They include 3 practice tests in the book with 2 others available online (these I haven't used myself). This is important because the TEAS test is different each time, you need to be exposed to as many different questions as possible. In fact, many of the questions in the book appeared word for word on the test and most of them were the same types of questions. My science and math grades were pathetic when I started and I improved after only a few hours. I tested myself to make sure I wasn't just commemorating the test responses - no, I was learning more and more every time I studied. The book works - they got the formula down. They combine the EXCELLENT ENSEIGNEMENT with the proper test preparation - you won't be blinded by going into the TEAS test. You'll know exactly how to deal with it. The TEAS test is a beast, however. Thus, the book is not perfect. But, it does prepare you extremely well and it still is worth 5 stars in my opinion. This is the end of the long version of my review. I thought I could also share some tips on the TEAS test itself: TIP ON THE TEST TEAS The reading section is not too difficult at all - the book prepares you very well for this section. Take your time, READ ALL. The biggest challenge is that it is tedious. But, this EASY POINTS. So, BIEN STUDY for reading, but if that's not your weakness, you can afford to spend more time on others. The math section is not very difficult at all - the book might even more prepare you for it. There is plenty of time to check your work and these can be EASY POINTS. In my experience, mathematics is one of my weaknesses and my highest score was mathematics - go figure. Figure. this, if math is your weakness, STUDY DUR. Since there are only 36 questions, a missed answer costs you much more. The scientific section was BRUTAL - which says a lot because anatomy is my strength. The reason is that there are so many different things that they could ask you and each question is random and not connected to each other - it's a complete random take bag. The book prepares you as well as it can and the things it teaches, you will remember and understand well. STUDY HARD. The language section is misleading and should be focused on highly, even if reading is your strength. The use of language and English is easily misunderstood and can be incredibly confusing. Many questions seem relative and opiniated, but there are rules to English just as accurate as mathematics - but, again, they are easily misunderstood. It is also misleading as there are only 28 questions - making errors more costly and they are not easy points. This book not only teaches well, but it lets you know what to expect - after going through it, you'll have a decent idea of how you're going to do it (although science is a wild card). If reading is not your weakness, I suggest studying for language, then science, then mathematics, then reading. Read a section, or part of a section, and then take the part of that section of the first practice test. The next day, read on and then pass the second test (this will make sure you're not just memorizing the test answers). Then finish the section and do the third test. Start a new section and repeat while taking all the sections you have in the past. Whenever you answer a question that you are not 100% sure about, mark it and read the explanation whether you got it or not. At the end of it, you will be very well prepared for the actual test. It was a long time, but I hope it was helpful. Good luck!
