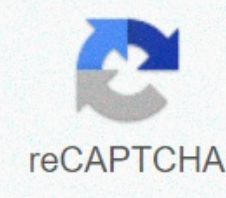

The mechanisms of the clock are the same, for they have a pendulum, chimes, face, hands and internal mechanisms that work in within the watch so that it can function properly. When a part malfunctions, the rest of the clock mechanisms can be thrown out of line and need to be adjusted. Gently open the back of the Tempus Fugit grandfather watch with slip-joint pliers. Check the spring of the clock to see if it's all right. Oil spring in pivot sections or replace spring with a new one if it is defective or too old. Use a small pair of pliers to remove it if necessary. Place a small amount of watch oil on the gears in the watch, and oil the clock mechanisms once every three years for maintenance. Examine the scales on your Tempus Fugit grandfather watch. Carefully remove the pendulum - which is the piece that swings back and forth - and set it aside. Make sure the scales are pulled up and in order. Look at the bottom of the weights where they are marked left, right and center; if tangled, adjust the weights so that they are in their right place. Hook the pendulum back up when the scales are adjusted. Make sure the pendulum is hung correctly. The shiny side of the pendulum should always face the front. Adjust the pendulum bob to regulate the speed of the watch. Push the bob up to run the clock faster or push it down to slow down the clock. Check your hands on the watch to make sure they don't touch. If they are stuck, gently move the minute hand away from the hour hand by turning it counterclockwise. Bend the minute hand towards you if your hands continue to touch or get stuck in place. Be careful not to interrupt any part of the hand when pulling, and always make sure that your hands do not rub against the watch face. Set the time by turning the minute hand clockwise to move forward in time or counterclockwise to go back. Pause every quarter of an hour as you move the minute hand clockwise until the clock ticks or you hear a click. Set the moon button on the watch next by pressing it as you rotate the dial to the right. Warnings Never move the hour alone to set the time. The movement controls the hour strike, time stand and chime. The pendulum and weights are critical components for the operation of the Grandpa Clock. The pendulum allows you to adjust and adjust the time adjustment. As described in these instructions, it is easy to adjust the pendulum to achieve accurate time adjustment. The three weights provide power for the hour strike (left weight), time (middleweight) and chime melody (right weight). Without these weights, Grandpa Clock wouldn't work. Each weight is different and must be hung correctly from the movement (left, center, right) to ensure proper operation. Weights are hung from the movement of a cable or chain. The scales must be raised at least every 7 years. Raising cable-powered weights is achieved using a crank. Raising chain driven weights are achieved by pulling down on the loose end of the chain. The strike and chime sounds are made of a series of hammers hitting different length rods. Each rod makes a different sound when hit by a hammer. Specific chime melodies are obtained by checking the sequence that each hammer hits a corresponding rod. This will contain your product manual. c) Remove the cardboard support of the cardboard side inside the carton. d) Remove the Grandpa Clock pendulum packed in a separate tall, thin cardboard box. e) Slide the clock out of one of the sides of the box. f) Gently go clockwise out of cardboard bottom support when out of the box. Located at the bottom of the shipping carton will be a white styrofoam box. This box contains: a) a key to fit your grandfather Clock door, b) a cranny that will be used to wind your grandfather Clock and, c) weights that drive the Grandpa Clock movement. Also within the shipping carton will be the Grandfather Clock pendulum packed in a separate cardboard box. Move the grandfather clock close to its final location. WARNING: MAKE SURE THE GRANDFATHER CLOCK IS PLACED SQUARE AND FIXED ON THE FLOOR SO IT WON'T FALL OVER. ADJUST LEVELING FOR MAXIMUM STABILITY AND CORRECT ADJUSTMENT. Access to Grandpa Clock movement, chimes and cables are made in three possible ways; through the front door(s), through the upper side panels (or side doors on some grandfather clocks), or through the rear access panel. The top side panels are held from the inside with tape or a plastic clip. The plastic clip can be rotated or the tape can be permanently removed. See the General Information section of section 10 for the correct instructions for removing and installing top-page panels. Remove the cardboard sleeve from around the germ rods by first cutting the elastic with scissors. DO NOT PULL THE ELASTIC TO BREAK. Then grasp the cardboard sleeve as marked and pull straight down and out the ends of the chimera bars. (See Figure 1.) Remove foam pads from between chime hammers and chime rods by first cutting elastic with scissors. DO NOT PULL THE ELASTIC TO BREAK. Care must be taken to avoid bending the chimpanzees. The chime hammers will be free to move providing easy removal of foam pads. Remove the spring clip from the back of the movement by first pulling one end free. (See Figure 1.) If there is a long cardboard sleeve and no rubber bands, simply pull down slowly on the cardboard sleeve from the front of the watch and the packing will release on its own. Then pull out the foam behind the chimpanzees and you have completed this step. DO NOT REMOVE THE STYROFOAM BLOCKS from above the cable disc. This is one of the most critical points in the entire setup. If you do so at this time, the cables can overlap and bind the movement. You can remove styrofoam blocks after your grandfather Clock is completely created and has been operating for about twelve hours or when they are completely free to remove. ____ Once in place, your grandfather Clock cabinet must be leveled, since Grandpa Clock may not work if it is not level. There are four leveling under the cabinet on each corner that can be screwed in (up) or out (down) to make adjustments. Place a level next to the Grandpa Clock enclosure from front to rear and from side to side, adjusting levels until level. It may be necessary to regularly check your cabinet after first setup, (especially if grandpa clock is on carpet) as it may settle after initial leveling. (see Figure 2). Make sure grandpa clock is placed square and fixed on the floor so that it will not fall over. ____ Some pendulums have a colored protective plastic film that covers the pendulum disc. Carefully remove this film before hanging the pendulum. Hang the pendulum and the pendulum, place the pendulum through the front door or one of the side or back or rear access panel locations. While holding the pendulum guide with one hand, slide the pendulum through the front door with the other hand. Place the pendulum hook over the pin or through the opening on the guide of the pendulum and lower the pendulum until it hangs securely on the pendulum guide. (See Figure 3.) ____ Most grandfather watches use three weights. The bottom of each weight is marked left, center or right facing Grandpa Clock. The total weight of each weight is slightly different, and each weight must be installed in its correct position for the grandfather clock to function properly. Check the scales to make sure they are tightly assembled. Make sure the cable is in the cable disc. Hang the scales on the pulleys. (See Figure 4.) ____ To set the moon disc, press lightly with your fingers on the front of the moon button. Turn the moon dial clockwise until the moon is directly below #15. (See Figure 5.) If the moon button does not rotate, wait 6 hours and try again. Never force the lunar disc as it should move easily. Using an almanac or calendar, determine the date of the last full moon. Count the number of days past the last full moon. Turn the moon dial one click for each day past the full moon. The moon button is now set and will indicate the correct lunar phases as the grandfather clock is continuously functioning. If the grandfather clock stops for more than 24 hours, the moon clock will also stop and must be reset when grandpa clock is started again. ____ SETTING TIME (MOVING hands) To set the time, only move the minute against the clock (backwards) until the hour and minute of the hand is at the right time. (See Figure 6) DO NOT MOVE THE HOUR HAND WHEN SETTING THE TIME. The hourhand moves automatically when the minute hand is moved. By moving the minute hand counterclockwise, it is not necessary to wait for grandpa clockwise to chime when the minute hand passes every quarter. (See Figure 6) The movement has a self-correcting function that synchronizes the bells over time. If after setting the Grandfather Clock on time, it does not chime properly, allow it to function 2 hours to correct itself. CAUTION WITH AUTOMATIC BELL LIGHT SEQUENCING: The bell selection lever must not be in the Auto position when moving your hands. Moving your hands in either clockwise or counterclockwise while the automatic chime sequencing is in operation may damage the chime mechanism. ____ Move the pendulum to the left of the center and release. Let Grandpa Clock operate for a few minutes until the pendulum settles in a smooth swinging motion. (See Figure 7) If your Grandfather Clock gains or loses time after twenty-four (24) hours, see General Information Section to regulate the timing of your grandfather Clock. After Grandpa Clock has been running for at least twenty-four (24) hours, remove the styrofoam blocks by lifting the blocks straight up until they clear the cable pulley. Attach your receipt to this guide for later use. ____ NEVER win a cable drive movement without weights installed. ____ Once removed, you have access to Grandpa Clock movement and chime area. The panels can be held in place during the shipment with tape or a plastic clip. To remove the panel, reach in through the front door and turn the plastic clip or remove the tape. Then follow these steps: 1. Grasp the wooden slats or knob with the tips of your fingers. Be careful not to push the grill cloth or glass on, as you can separate it from the pull wall. 2. Lift up the top sidebar. It rests in a groove on the lower edge. 3. Slide the bottom edge of the top side panel toward the center of the case while at the same time, pulling the top edge down and out of the groove at the top of the opening. 4. Tilt the top edge of the top sidebar toward the case center. 5. Remove the top side bar from the frame opening, first at the lower end. When you install wood or glass top side panels reverse step 1 to 5. ____ Cables with pulleys: Weights suspended by cables with pulleys must be raised using the specified crane. DO NOT lift the weights with your hand during cranking. Insert the cranial swing into the cranial holes on the dial side (see Figure 15) and turn the cranial swing counterclockwise. This will increase the weights. You can not overcome Grandpa Clock and weights must be near the top to run Grandpa Clock in 7 days. Be sure to remove the cranly before closing the door. ____ The pendulum is moved up or down by turning the adjustment nut. To slow the grandfather clock down, move the pendulum disk down by turning the adjustment nut to the left. To speed up the grandfather clock, move the pendulum set up by turning the adjustment nut to the right. (See Figure 17.) Day one 1. Choose a time of day that allows you to check your grandfather clock at the same time for at least six days. 2. Record time selected. 3. Check the correct time. 4. Return the minute hand to the exact correct time. Day two, three, Five, Six (if necessary) 1. Check the correct time. 2. Compare the time displayed on your grandfather clock with correct time. Is Your Grandfather Clock Fast or Slow? 3. Turn the adjustment nut on the pendulum a complete rotation for every half minute quickly or slowly per day. (24 hours). 4. Check the correct time. 5. Return the minute hand to the exact correct time. You can read more about how to keep the pendulum exactly here ____ There are 3 options on this lever. 1) Night On - This will keep the chime striking 24 hours 2) Night Off - This position will turn off the germ between 10:15 and 7:00 3) Strike - This position will allow the movement to hit the hour without the Westminster melody if the other Westminster melody lever is turned to Silent. ____ Some models play only Westminster chimes, while others give you a selection of three tunes. Choosing the chime sequencing function or one of the three chiming melodies is done with the selector lever. If the dial is called Chime-Silent, your grandfather Ur has only Westminster chimes. If your grandfather Clock has a triple chime movement, the chime handle identifies melody choices. All the floor grandpa clock movements have Big Ben time gong, which will count the hour, on the hour. DO NOT try to move chime choice handles while Grandpa Clock is the germ. Doing so may damage the chime mechanism. See Figure 18 for when it is safe to move the chime selection handle without damaging the movement. DRAG THE USER SELECTOR FOR RINGING A BELL ONLY WHEN THE MINUTE HAND IS IN A SECURE TIME AREA ____ DIFFICULTY TURNING THE MOON BUTTON When facing the grandfather clock, remove the top sidebar, open the side door, or remove the rear access panel. Look at the back of the dial and find click spring. Put your finger on the tip of the click spring. Pull the click spring about 1/2 away from the sawntand motion, then release. (See Figure 19.) Click spring and dial should snap in correct alignment. If the click spring is in its proper position and you still feel resistance when you try to promote the moon button, DO NOT FORCE IT. If the moon button is still not easy to advance, this indicates that the gears that automatically push the moon button are activated. To correct this rotate minute hand backwards three hours as described in step 5 of the setup. ____ You can read more about how to set your Moon Dial on your grandfather watch here 16. GRANDFATHER CLOCK DOES NOT GERM AT PROPER TIME If Grandpa Clock chimes more than a minute before or after the right time, the minute hand should be removed and adjusted. CAUTION: When performing this action, be careful not to scratch the hand nut, hand or dial. 1. When Grandpa Clock starts to chime, stop the pendulum and record the time. 2. Use seaweed, carefully remove the small nut that holds the minute hand in place by turning the nut counterclockwise, while at the same time holding the minute hand with your fingers near the small nut. 3. Remove the hand from the hand shaft by grasping it with your fingers at the point where it is attached to the shaft. Pull your hand straight. This hand is not screwed on and should come out easily. Minute hand has a small raised area on the back directly around the shaft hole, this is hand bushing. Use seaweed, grip bushing firmly at the sides so that it cannot slide in the pliers. With the other hand, turn the grandfather clock hand forward or backward the distance needed to germinate at the right time. (See Figure 20.) 4. Re-attach the hand to the shaft and turn the hand nut finger tightly. Make sure your hand points to the correct location that you registered in step 1, plus any corrections you made in step 3. If the hand does not point to the correct mark, repeat steps 2 and 3. 5. Put the hand nut with the tong. Don't tighten too much. 6. Start pendulum. 7. Rescing the time by moving only the minute hand counterclockwise (backwards) as described in step 5 of the setup. EXAMPLE: Grandpa Clock chimes at 1:10, but should chime at 1:15. Step 1: When Grandpa Clock chimes at 1:10 stop the pendulum and record the time of 1:10. Step 2: Carefully remove the small nut. Step 3: Remove the minute hand. Grab the bushing next to its sides and turn your hand forward 5 minutes. Step 4: Put your hand back on to point to 1:15. Fasten hand nut finger tightly. Step 5: Put the hand dryer. Step 6: Start pendulum. Step 7: Reset grandpa clock to current time. ____ GRANDFATHER CLOCK DOES NOT BEAT THE CORRECT HOUR If, after several hours of operation, your grandfather clock does not hit the correct hour, only grab the TIME HAND and move it forward or backward to correct the correcting hour on the dial indicated by the number of times the hour hits. Rotating this hand independently will not damage the grandfather clock. If you want to reset the minute hand (to correct it), move the minute hand counterclockwise (backwards) as described in step 5; Setting time. ____ Make sure the selection handle is not in silent position or halfway between two chimes 2. Make sure that all packaging material is removed from the range of motion. 3. Make sure that the scales hang at the correct place Check the label at the bottom of each weight to ensure correct position. 4. For models with the night sound barrier, make sure that the grandfather clock is not in silence mode at night. (Reference: See AUTOMATIC NIGHTTIME SEWING OPTION in the General Information section.) 5. Check the hammer adjustment and correct the chime tone as needed. 6. Move the chime selection handle to another melody or to silent. 7. It is possible that the handlebars above the cable discs bind the cable. Carefully remove the handlebars by lifting the blocks straight up until they clear the cable disc. Gently push them back through the cables. Do not use tools to remove the blocks.
