They finished second in 2005, the first time they did not participate in the national competition in eight years. Recently, in the NYS competition for the Nationals, the 2008 team finished second, while the 2010 team finished third. Debate Schreiber's Lincoln-Douglas debate team was nationally dominant from 2003 to 2005, with three students taking several national titles. The team has since transformed itself into a Public Forum Debate team, winning the Varsity Public Forum New York State Championship in 2009. In April 2011, the team finished second in the Public Forum of the New York State Championship. Schreiber's debate team is again successful, achieving results at the 2016 Princeton Classic. In recent years, members of the various ensembles have been chosen to perform in select quotes, including the All-State orchestra and bands. For the 2008–09 school year, 11 Schreiber students were selected as all-state musicians and alternates. In 2010–11 years, 5 students were selected as all-state musicians and alternate, and one year later 8 students were selected. The school march band also has commendable achievements. The marching band has performed and marched in Sugar Bowl Parade (1989), Orange Bowl Parade (1990) and tournament of roses parade (1996). In May 2000, schreiber concert band performed and won several awards at a high school band tournament in Hershey, PA. In the fall of 2000, the Paul D. Schreiber Marching Band performed seventy-six trombones from the musical The Music Man at the tenth annual Lauri Strauss Leukemia Foundation Benefit Concert at Carnegie Hall. The Research Program Schreiber has a nationally recognized research program in mathematics, science and social sciences. [14] There have been many local and national winners from the school's research program. Students compete in a variety of competitions, including the Siemens Competition, Long Island Science and Engineering Fair and the Intel International Science and Engineering Fair. The school's research program has achieved nationwide recognition through student success in the Intel Science Talent Search competition. [15] From 2002 to 2010, the school had the sixth most in the country with 50, trailing only Montgomery Blair High School (08), Stuyvesant High School (103), Ward Melville High School (85), Thomas Jefferson High School for Science and Technology (75), and Bronx High School of Science (59). [16] In the last years of January 2008, the school produced six Intel Science Talent Search semi-finalists, the second highest total on Long Island. [17] In addition, two finalists were selected from the school. Schreiber was just one of two schools that produced double finalist winners. [18] Along with Great Neck North High School, Schreiber produced the second most finalists in the country, and followed only Stuyvesant High School of Manhattan. [19] A student from Schreiber was chosen to be one of the top 10 winners of the Intel Science Talent Search 2008, winning a \$20,000 scholarship. The student was ninth place winner for a zoology project based on Odonate populations. [20] Eight semi-finalists in the Intel Science Talent Search were selected from Schreiber in 2006, and were named the second most semifinalist in the country with Stuyvesant High School. [21] The performance of the semifinalists marks the fourth consecutive year that Schreiber High School has been among the top five schools in the United States. That same year, Schreiber also produced a finalist in the competition, which ended up winning the Glenn Seaborg Prize. 2000 In 2000, nine semifinalists were selected, leading all schools on Long Island.
