Confusion and/or disorientation are also common. And if you inhale a large amount of carbon monoxide, you could get high or die. If individuals sleep or are drunk are exposed to carbon monoxide, they can die without ever showing symptoms. Detectors listed by Underwriters Laboratories (UL) are verified to have a minimum alarm of 85 decibels that is audible within 10 feet of the unit. However, as Allen, our internal cleaning expert points out, alarm sound levels or decibels are important but are measured near the device. If you are away from the device, the sound is less audible. That's why it's important to have more than one carbon monoxide detector in a larger house or apartment. You need to be able to hear the alarm, no matter where you are in space. If you have problems with hearing loss, you can find carbon monoxide detectors with alarms that vary their frequencies, making them easier to feel. You can also find carbon monoxide detectors with strobe lights. This type of signal is useful for those who are completely deaf. Some carbon monoxide detectors have vocal alarms. This can be useful in a family of deep sleepers. Children, in particular, can benefit from a voice alarm, as they can sleep through a beep. Power sourceManas carbon monoxide detectors run on battery power, which allows them to work even during a power outage. Batteries must be replaced at least every year to ensure that the detector is always running properly. Many models chirp or beep to let it be known that the batteries are running low. There are some battery-powered carbon monoxide detectors that use lithium batteries, which can last the duration of the detector. Other carbon monoxide detectors connect to outlets, and some models can be wired into your home's power circuits. None of these types can be run in the event of a power outage, however. These devices can be convenient because you don't need to install multiple detectors of different types throughout the house. If you have a carbon monoxide detector with digital visualization, install it at eye level so that it is easy to read. Test carbon monoxide detectors at least once a month to make sure they work properly. Most manufacturers recommend replacing batteries in battery-powered carbon monoxide detectors at least once a year. If you hear your detector ringing or chirping, replace the batteries immediately. Replace the carbon monoxide detector every five years or earlier if necessary. If the carbon monoxide detector sounds a warning, exit immediately for fresh air. Make sure everyone in the house, including pets, evacuates. Make sure the whole family understands difference between the sounds of the carbon monoxide detector and the smoke detector. This way, your family will know who to call for an emergency and what to tell them. Battery-powered carbon monoxide detectors and plug-ins are easy to install on your own. A wired detector must be installed by a professional. Check the oven or heating system regularly to make sure it is in proper operation. This can help reduce the risk of carbon monoxide poisoning. Q. What is the appropriate number of carbon monoxide detectors for a home? A. This depends on the layout and size of the house. You should have at least one CO detector on each floor. That said, it's a good idea to place one out of each bedroom so that every family member definitely hears the warning if it sounds. It is also necessary to place a carbon monoxide detector within 15-20 feet of the furnace or any heat source that burns fuel. Q. Is a digital carbon monoxide detector safer than other types of carbon monoxide detectors? A. A digital carbon monoxide detector is often the best option to keep your home safe because it shows you when carbon monoxide is present, even a small amount. This could allow you to respond before carbon monoxide reaches a dangerous level. Q. What should I do if my carbon monoxide detector sounds a warning? A. Evacuate your home immediately. If someone in the family is experiencing symptoms of carbon monoxide poisoning, call 911 from a mobile phone or neighbor's house. If no one has symptoms, call the local fire department or a qualified technician so your home can be inspected. If you are unable to evacuate your home, open as many windows and doors as possible and call for help. You should also turn off any sources of carbon monoxide if possible. Power.
