Getty Images How much can you really say about a person just from their postcode? According to Esri, a geographical information company, the answer is quite a lot. Esri's website has a zip-lookup tool that allows visitors to find demographic information for every zip code in the United States. So while you already know the best conditions to find a new home, you can now learn more about each particular neighborhood to find one that's best for you. Here's how it works: Esri's Tapestry segmentation divides neighborhoods into 67 different segments based on socioeconomic and demographic composition to provide a snapshot of what life is like in every place. For example, the tapestry of Beverly Hills' famous 90210 zip code indicates that 73 percent of residents are classified as top tiers (aka they're super rich and have everything they've ever wanted), 20 percent are labeled trendsetters (aka they're young professionals who care about the finer things in life), and 8 percent are in their retirement years. You may be able to find more information about this and similar content, piano.io If you've ever wondered which zip codes are the most expensive in the United States, listen: RealtyHop, a real estate investment website, has compiled a list of the priciest American postcodes based on real estate listings so far in 2020. Only 11 states host the top 100 zip codes, with California the pack at the top 68.To determining which zip codes are the most priciest this year, RealtyHop took every real estate listing advertised in the U.S. (that's 3.2 million, BTW) and sorted them by zip code and median price. Atherton, Calif. (94027) tops the list, as on lists of other companies in recent years, with an average list price of 8.65 million U.S. dollars. Los Angeles itself has 10 of the 100 most expensive postcodes in the country, which is the most a city has. California is 68 in the top 100, followed by New York with 20—including Sagaponack, Water Mill and New York City. This leaves 12 postcodes to other states. In addition to postcodes in California and New York, Fisher Island, Florida (33109) is second only to Atherton List. It's the only zip code in the top 10 that doesn't come from those two states. Other postcodes that made the top 100 are Media, WA (98039); Alpine, NJ (7620); Greenwich, CT (06830); Paradise Valley, AZ (85253); Kenilworth, IL (60043); and more. We can thank you for this at a certain TV show in Beverly Hills. Apart from that, the general knowledge of these five-digit numbers is rather limited. We put them at the end of the addresses, and then our mail is magically delivered to the right place. But through some clever methods of detection (online research), we discovered one of the most guarded secrets that all postmen know: what postcodes really are and how they work. (Ok, so it's not really a secret, but now you have something to talk to their mailer.) Learn how to help the USPS now. Why do we use postal codes? The whole practice of using postcodes is a relatively new system, which was introduced on 1 July 1963. Previously, from 1943, the U.S. Postal Service used a number of postal zones only for large cities. If you were to write an address, that number would go by city and before the state, and postmen would use it to sort emails more efficiently. See what postal delivery looked like 100 years ago. What does each number in a zip code mean? In 1944, a postal worker named Robert Moon came up with an idea for a new post-zone system to cover the entire country. The first number would represent a group of states, starting from zero on the East Coast and ending at nine on the West Coast, and the second and third numbers would indicate which section center facility (the location where emails are processed and distributed) the mail in this area should go. The U.S. Postal Service eventually approved this plan by adding two numbers at the end to indicate the correct post office or postal zone, and so the Zone Improvement Plan Code – or postal code – was born. Check out these other surprising facts about the U.S. Post Office. What do the four numbers at the end of a zip code mean? About 20 years after the first postcodes were put into operation, the Post Office has made another change to the system: the four digits that come after your postcode. These represent a specific area that each post office covers. The sixth and seventh figures refer to a supply sector which could be a group of roads, a large building or another small geographical area. The last two represent a delivery segment, such as the floor of an office building or a side of the street. There is also an option to search the postal code card by company or all cities within a specific ZIP code. The postcode system began in the early 1960s. Today, postal codes are used in sales and marketing applications, Internet technology, and data collection. When the zip codes began, they were used to determine where to send a piece of email. The ZIP Code format consists of five digits, and then the extended version contains the five digits along with a hyphen and four other digits. In 1944, Robert Moon presented his proposal for the postcode system while working as a postal inspector for the Post Office. However, Moon received only the first three digits of the five-digit zip code. In 1963, non-compulsory postal codes were listed for the whole country. In 1967, these postcodes were made mandatory for all second- and third-class mass prepes. Soon after, the system was made mandatory for all shipping items. The postcode tabulation ranges (ZCTAs) are real representations of the USPS POST code ranges. They are generalized and are also inserted into a map shape. They are created by first finding blocks and then assigning an entire count block to the postal code that occurs most often on the block. Like most countries and territories, Israel has a large number of postcodes. Israeli postal codes consist of a series of numbers that indicate the specific region and city of a specific address. Postal services use the code to quickly forward e-mail to the intended recipient. Postcodes in Israel follow a specific pattern that begins in the northern region of the state, with the numbers gradually increasing for each additional area along this path. Israel's postcode system follows the same type of numbering as in other countries, with one exception. While Israel traditionally followed a five-digit system, it switched to a seven-digit system in 2013. While the postcodes initially became more confusing, the idea behind the change was to open up the possibility of more addresses. Under the old five-digit system, mail was limited to only 100,000 possible codes. Since the change, however, 10 million unique postal codes have been possible. With a growing population of almost eight million citizens, the seven-digit postcode system was a much-needed change to the addressing system.
