There are many different approaches students can take to multiply and divide with rational numbers, and some of these approaches can be more efficient or easier than others, especially when looking carefully at the expression's structures and thoughts quantitatively about their values (MP.7 and MP.2). Using the examples, there are the various brain students approach to attacking each one; besides the strategies mentioned in the scores and guiding questions, students bound to come up with other major approaches.
