Written by Cory Levins If you have dealt with dangerous goods (also commonly referred to as hazardous materials) in any form, you have probably heard of the hazardous goods (DGR) provisions put forward by the International Air Transport Association (IATA). They are known to release an updated version of their IATA DGR manual that is considered to be the global reference for shipping dangerous goods by air and the only standard recognized by airlines. It is difficult to provide every detail about IATA DGR in this article, as the manuals are 900-1000 pages long and each page is covered with technical information that spans all safety options regarding the handling of dangerous goods. Therefore, the main highlights will be covered. IATA DGR starts immediately with a clear and defined definition of dangerous goods: dangerous goods are objects or substances that may pose a risk to health, safety, property or the environment and are listed in the list of dangerous goods in these Regulations or which are classified under these Regulations. Training is mandatory for anyone who interacts with the dangerous goods at any point in the transport process. Training and testing must be carried out before any person can be considered qualified to work with dangerous goods. General training should be provided to all workers and specific safety training that will help workers to act quickly in emergencies. All training sessions must be thoroughly documented in sufficient detail and instructors must be qualified to teach the material. Dangerous goods are divided into 9 separate classes: Class 1 – Explosives Class 2 – Gases Class 3 – Flammable liquids class 4 – Flammable solids; Substances that can ignite Substances which emit in contact with water flammable gases class 5 oxidising substances and organic peroxides Class 6 — Toxic and infectious substances Class 7 – Radioactive material class 8 — Corrosive substances class 9 — Various hazardous goods Each class gets its own detailed description to ensure they are unique from together with specialised packaging instructions to ensure that the dangerous goods are transported and handled safely. Specific information on the packaging process is provided. IATA DGR requires that certain packaging regulations and requirements are met, regardless of the class of dangerous goods shipped. Certain safety containers are better suited for certain classes of dangerous goods. There are also several performance tests that need to be performed and passed before shipping. Once the tests have been completed, rules are laid down for how the packages should be marked. You must use specific labels and posters that are configured for a specific color, size, font of text, and language. The documentation to be attached to the package containing the dangerous goods is also described in great detail. IATA DGR provides a step-by-step framework for the application of the Regulations. Knowing that it is unrealistic to expect workers to know exactly which side to turn to in moments of urgency, the guidebook begins with a 20-step framework that takes the reader through a check to ensure that all the necessary requirements for classification, marking, marking, and documentation are adequately met. It is short in its length, but it accounts for each scenario and mishap that could happen in the process. At each step, the relevant sections referenced are specified. Every year within the month of January, a new version of the manual is released with all the previous material from the previous one, along with any recorded changes made since the publication of the previous edition. The fact that this book is constantly updated to reflect changes while maintaining strict and clearly written guidelines is what makes it an internationally respected handbook for safety.
