Player, with a smithing level of 60, for example, it would cost 70% of the normal cost:

 Simply put, each 2 forging level reduces repair costs by 1% compared to the NPC supplier by 1%. At level 99, this is equivalent to about 50% of savings. The damaged vest can also be repaired under the vest and give the player's plate body randomly on a metal bronze mithril. Broken treads can also be repaired to stand and give the player plate legs or plateskirt randomly metal, bronze mithril. There's a chance that the armoured will crush it outside the repairs. Recovery: One of the best ways to get Construction XP is to do something, remove it then remake it again. Some of the good things to use for it are: Fireplaces, dining tables and larders. The most common furniture that people restore to train their construction level is Oak Lard (requires 33 Construction) Another good example is pickaxe and move into their house in Rimmington. Go to the mine of the Northeast POH portal of Rimmington and my Clay. Then use the clay in your sink and go into building mode. Build Clay's fireplaces and restore it. Repeat this procedure over and over again. Another bracelet Clay could use, allowing you to have my Wet Clay. Sawmill: When training in construction, it is recommended that you hire a staff member because you can send them to the sawmill. If you don't have a lot of money, then bring an axe and chop trees or oak trees depending on what plank you want outside the POH portal. Go to your house and send your servant to the sawmill. If you have a lot of money, then buy the amount of logs you want to have changed planks. Take all logs to mark the form and head to your house. Ask your butler to tell you the inventory of the logs. When they come back, ask them to take the logs to the mill. As soon as they return to the sawmill you can start building the objects. Make sure you have enough money to pay for the servant and the cost of planks. Easy Saws and Hammers If you have a Workshop and have built Tool Store 1, you can catch and hammer while searching your tool shop. This is useful when teleporting your house using runes. Sacred Clay Hammer Violate and Morpnic tools. rewards stealing creation action, can change clay hammer. The corrupt tool will randomly change to a new tool and give 120% extra experience before it breaks down. On the other hand, the Morpnic tool becomes a tool of your choice and keep that form before desintergrates. However, the morpnic tool provides only 100% extra experience before it disappears. Guild trophies and vests stands To get some extra xp, make vests standing (Skill hall, 28 construction) or Guild trophies (Quest hall, 47 construction) they give more xp then regular xp, but if you remove the object, you can return a special item(s). For example, the Cape Legends trophy requires 3 teak planks (270xp) and Cape legends (30xp), which makes a total of 300xp. If you remove it, you'll get your cape of legends back. Back to the top Many shortcuts require players to bring a crossbow and wrestle or rope every time they want to use them, but some materials With a high enough construction level, you can build hidey-holes and rope racks to make sure they are fine to use each time. Crystal Saw Evil Stew Tea Crystal Saw adds +3 to its construction level, but it only works with furniture; you cannot use it to build higher-level spaces than you normally build. Crystal Saws can only be after completing the quest for Eyes gloughphrie. After being used 24 times, they return to a small crystal seed and must be loaded into a crystal bowl in the Brimstail cave, inside Gnome Stronghold. Crystal saw bonuses stack with Evil Stew or Tea, and did not directly affect your construction level statistics menu. Evil Stew, made after rescuing Evil Dave as part of the Recipe for Disaster Quest, can raise or reduce the variety of skills that the player has. Evil stew with orange spices can affect your construction until the range of about -6 to +6 stews with three orange spices mixed. It is best to make several stews in advance because they are unpredictable and do not always raise the construction. For more information about Tea, see the guide to the higher part of the road. To return Top XP rewards to guests, see quest experience guide special report. The return of the top builder's clothes is a possible reward for the Temple Trekking/Burgh de Rott Ramble minigame, which requires 44 Construction to wear. Once worn out, each piece will give you an additional experience when building furniture for your POH. Back to the top Once you have reached level 99, you can visit a real estate agent to buy a Building Cape 99,000 Coins. Once you have reached the level of 120, the real estate agent will sell you the Construction Master Cape 120,000 Coins. Please note that another Mod Daze Easter egg has been found since December 2018. This allows you to buy Skillcape at half the price (only real estate agent, not Elen) if you are ring Charos (a).
