Many people choose their truck based on their gut because their grandfather worked at Ford or because their dad drove a Ram. But for people who want to sit a spell and think things through, there are a lot of options out there. Different trucks have different powers, and they change more often than we realize. As all vehicles have grown bigger and bigger, there has been a recent increase in sales in medium-sized truck models, as well as new interest from manufacturers in offering smaller truck sizes. It can be beyond confusion to pick a truck for purchase. After all, there's a lot to consider. With all the different model sizes to choose from, each with its own unique cabin and bed size combinations, there is a dizzying array of offers for comparison. Trucks can also get quite expensive, so it pays to be a smart buyer and really consider all your options! Here are some of the best according to buyer reviews and car reviewers to help you make sense of everything. The be-all and end-all of Chevy pickups can tow up to 20,000 pounds (the dual-version diesel rear wheel) and carry a 6,112-pound payload (the double-rear non-diesel version). By choosing to double up on double wheels or nail in all-wheel drive, you can set this thing up to pull anything anywhere, up to 26,500 pounds. The worst part about these trucks is the price. On average, you'll be spending about \$60,000 on an F-350. The Dodge Ram 3500 has a 900 lb-ft of torque and a maximum towing score of £31,210 when upgrading to the Aisin gearbox. The engines range from a 6.7-liter turbodiesel inline 6 to a 410-hp, 6.4-liter V-8. With all that, the heavy-duty Rams don't have that sluggish feel many heavy-duty pickups have. Just based on the sheer power of driving this monster, you can't go wrong, especially for \$35,000. Just because Silverado gets slightly slightly praise does not mean that Sierra is a slouch. The cabin is quiet and comfortable, and if you can pay for the Denali, you're rolling along in luxury over a 6.2-liter V8. The differences are mainly cosmetic. You pay for luxury (prices start at \$35,600), but you can be sure that this truck carrying the same hard intestines as the Silverado. The GMC Canyon is great for a compact/medium-sized pickup, but suffers a little from comparison to the duo's Chevrolet, Colorado.
