Department of Transit Administration functions: to provide quality and accessible public transportation to Jefferson Parish residents. This section monitors fixed-contract track operators as well as mobility disruption of the transport system (MITS). The petition and the Federal Financial Aid Administration prepare the specifications of the proposal and monitor the request for proposals. On a daily basis, staff answer questions about bus routes and other transit issues. Five questions are often asked: 1. Why not Start earlier and run later? The Transit Department is under very tight financial constraints. Buses must be scheduled when there are enough riders to justify the cost of running them. Current programs have been developed over the years, reflecting the start and end time, which are justified by stirring. The timing of bus routes is determined both at cost and by demand. All routes begin at 6:30 a.m. or .m, and most buses are .m 9 or 10 p.m. . 2. Can you put a shelter bus station or bench in this place? Requests of this type are considered individually. To make such a request, contact the Transit Department at 364-3450 or send a letter to: Department of Transit Department, 21 Westbank Highway, Gretna, Louisiana 70053. Shelters and benches are placed at those stations with the highest number of people getting on the bus as shown by periodic surveys. Bus stops are determined by demand. Shelters and benches are at stops showing higher boarding numbers. There are a limited number of shelters. Because they put on concrete slabs they are harder to move from one place to another. 3. Why can I call MITS the day I want to ride? Trips on MITS may well be scheduled in pre-ahead but not on the same day you wish to ride. The driver's plans should be prepared and printed the night before the driver knows his route for the entire day. So trips should be scheduled at least one day before you wish to travel. There are a limited amount of rides available on MITS daily. Therefore, the ride must be planned in advance to accommodate each stirrup. You can schedule an appointment up to a week ago. If you plan later you may have to negotiate when there are gaps available. To plan a ride call 889-7156. Out-of-town riders are welcome. 4. How do I get across the Long Hoy P. Bridge to the Elmwood area? The long hue-pee route provides services across the Long Hui Pi Bridge to Elmwood. Jefferson Transit routes connect EastBank and WestBank. A transmission point in Drake near the West Bank Highway connects the long Huy Pei route to the Avondale route and connects with the West Bank Highway route at Walkertown Terminal. On the Jefferson Highway, it connects with the local Kenner bus. For more information, visit Jefferson Transit's home page. 5. What bus to get from here to there?
