Garmin nuvi 55lm battery replacement

To avoid losing important data stored in Garmin brand quilted GPS receivers by Tanya Robertson, you need to back up your data periodically. You should also back up your data before downloading updates to Nuvi. There are two ways to store information in Nuvi: the internal memory of the device and the removable SD card. Preloaded maps and other information that came with the device are stored in internal memory. The maps or other information you add are stored on your SD card. Connect Nuvi to your computer via a USB cord. On the computer, click Start. Depending on your PC, double-click My Computer or Computer. Right-click the Garmin/Quilt drive. Click the Garmin folder and drag and hold the button while you drag and drop the folder onto the screen. This copies all internal data stored in Nuvi. To back up only specific things, you can double-click the Garmin folder, double-click the GPX folder, and then drag and drop each specific file that you want to copy to the desktop. Save the file in a more permanent place. You can save the file elsewhere on your computer, such as in the Documents folder, by right-clicking the file, selecting Send, and then clicking Document. You can also transfer files to an external hard drive by connecting to the hard drive, right-clicking the file, selecting Send, and then clicking the drive on which you want to send the file. The third option is to burn from a CD/DVD using your computer disc burning software. Remove the SD card from Nuvi. Press with your finger until you click the card. Then the card will come out about 1/4 inch and the rest can take it out. Insert the SD card into the specified slot on the computer. The slot is approximately 1 inch long and is called SD. Insert the card into the drive and slide it in until you click the card. If your computer does not have an SD card slot, you can use an external SD card reader or a multi-card reader that uses your computer's USB drive. Press the card on the drive until you hear a click on the card, and then connect the USB cable to the USB drive on your computer. You can get an external SD card reader from any electronics store. The replacement battery required is a CR2032 lithium coin cell 3 volt battery, which is commonly available in grocery stores and pharmacies. Here's how to replace the battery: Locate the battery module on the back of the heart rate strap transmitter device, and then remove the plastic ring with your finger. Remove the four screws on the back of the Garmin module. On older models without Garmin screws, use coins to turn the battery cover counterclockwise. Remove the cover, and then tap the back of the module to drain the old battery. Garmin waits 30 seconds. Otherwise, the new battery may not be recognized. Place the new battery in a compartment with the positive (+) side facing up. Garmin replaces the back cover, screws and rubber rings around the battery module. After replacing the Garmin battery, you may need to pair the heart rate monitor strap with your fitness device again. To pair the User's Guide, refer to the User's Guide.
