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obedience and sacrifice, has focused on the plan of salvation. From everything declared by God's prophets, we know that this is true. However, this is the way to go. And there is no other way. What does that mean? Exclude other rituals and processes? Will it no longer make the law of Moses binding on Nephi and his future generation? Because (for example, Jarom 1:5; Alma 25:15), there is no other way did not mean that the Nephites would abandon the practice of rituals. Nor is it about abandoning the rituals that are now in place in our time. Rituals are not essential, but the purpose of ordinances is essential. The fundamental meaning is essential. The Doctrine of Christ enables you to understand, live, and receive ordinances as you follow ordinances. They are help to bring you on this right path. You honor them, follow them, and ask them to inherit the blessings of the Doctrine of Christ. Why are rituals enacted? They bring you where you inherit with your body. Spirit these great blessings of the Doctrine of Christ. They will prepare you. The effect is to qualify, direct, and advance you toward this goal of receiving the blessings found in the doctrine of Christ described by Nephi in this chapter. When ordinances are adopted, they are rarely ignored and received what was promised by the Doctrine of Christ. How can we reject what is on offer and still accept the underlying gifts? Therefore, is it important to keep the ritual intact? If some of the communication involved in preparing to receive the Doctrine of Christ changes, will something be lost? For example, there can be no contract without shedding blood. The blood of Christ is the best thing that sheds blood to activate the covenant between God and man. But even after christ's sacrifice, we still need to provide sacrifice, and even the return of animal sacrifice happens at some point in this final dispensing. The law of Moses is fulfilled and will not come back. But the blood sacrifices made by animals before the law of Moses come back. As Joseph Smith taught, These [animal] sacrifices, all ordinances belonging to the priesthood, will be fully restored and will follow all powers, influences, and blessings when the Lord's temple is built and Levi's sons are cleansed. This and ever will exist when the power of the Melchizedek priesthood is clear enough. Others can pass on how to return all the things spoken about my holy prophet. It is not understood that the law of Moses will be reestablished by its ordinances and various ordinances. This has never been told by the Prophet. But what existed before the time of Moses, the sacrifice, continues. (TPJS, p. 173, D.H.C.4:212) When penalties existed in temple priesthood ordinances, we remembered the shed of blood needed for covenants. If removed, some of that memory will be lost. How will the penalties involving the shed of blood prepare people for the return of animal sacrifices, and will it help to remember that they need to shed blood to establish covenants? Even this final dispensation of the completeness of time was not an effective contract without shedding blood to seal testimonies or contracts. (D& C 135: 3.Does the Gospel of Jesus Christ require all sacrifices?) (We previously explained in relation to lectures on faith.) If so, how can we obtain the blessings we desire from God's hands without having to make similar sacrifices? If necessary, how can we qualify for this baptism that Nephi has spoken about, to purge us of all our sins and to forgive us? Speak with a new tongue? How can this sacrifice be made separately from the irrevocable determination to endure to the end by placing everything on the altar that even has his own life, if necessary, to build the kingdom of God? In a fallen world, on a day when others sacrifice or consecrated, how they are filled with sin. How do you do it? What can the Doctrine of Christ do, regardless of the sins or errors we find around us? Even if the world is content to remain telestic, few encourage us to obey the laws of the earth, and can you still find and live the doctrine of Christ? Can you do this in private, between you and God? Concluding the exposition on the doctrine of Christ, the statement said: The only true doctrine of the Father and The Son and the name of the Holy Spirit, one God, ends without end. Amen is a formula used when using seal permissions, although only a few are aware of this. If you know this, you will find that what Nephi has done is declared to have a paterentic priesthood right, including the power to always seal. He will again mention sealing his testimony before making a conclusion. But if you know that this is an expression adopted in relation to this authority, you will recognize it. In Church ordinances, we use this formula to baptize and seal marriages in the temple. All other intermediate ordinances are performed in the name of Jesus Christ.
