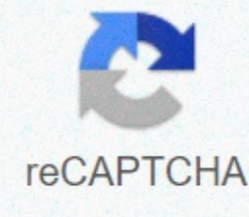

## La leccion de august resumen

To conclude this month of children and the Spanish language, I will discuss the novel's August lessons by American author R. J. Palacio of Hispanic descent, the pseudonym of Raquel Jaramillo. The August lesson (surprised in its original version) is about a child, August Auggie Pullman, who suffers from Treacher Collins syndrome, a condition that affects facial bones and appears in 1 in 50,000 births. In order not to extend much about Treacher Collins syndrome, I suggest you look for it. The novel was about to first be studied at a school in August, because by then he had studied at home, and how his disorder affects his social relationships at school. August lives with his parents, Nate and Isabel, and his sister Olivia through North River Heights, north of Manhattan. The August text divided 127 chapters into eight parts. However, each part has a different amount: the first part, the longest, is chapter 35; Second, 16; The third, which is the smallest with the seventh, is 6; Fourth, 20; Fifth, 8; sixth, 11; Seventh, 6th, just like third and finally, owns the eighth 25. It takes place in New York City from September to June, i.e. a school year. There is also a special detail in the August text. Each of the eight parts is narrated from the point of view of some character in the book, a literary resource that has become popular thanks to George R. R. Martin's ice and fire song book series, though in Martin's case this resource is used per chapter as his novel parts are not divided. In addition, the text of August is fully pronounced in the first person. The statements of each of the parts of the novel are as follows: This is how characters appear under their point of view Part One: August I Part Two: Part Three via: Summer Part Four: Jack Part Five: Justin Part Five: August II Seventh Part: Miranda Part Eight: August III I will analyze the characters in order of storytelling. In general, most characters have self-esteem and family issues that they have to deal with but they certainly can't compare to the people of August. August Auggie Pullman is an eleven-year-old boy of a Jewish father and mother of Brazilian descent. You have Tiger Collins syndrome or mandibulofacial dissisis, which affects your face, ears and way of eating. By the time she was eleven, her mother educated her at home, abandoning her career as a children's book draftsman, as they feared Auggie would not be accepted to a school. At that age she's

enrolled in Beecher, a private middle school2, starting a challenge for her: social with other kids, something that seems difficult, but that she assumed over time. he Star Wars is a very good student, with a great talent for and for science. Despite being well received by Mr Tushman (Rearnian in Spanish Translation) 3, the principal of Beecher, most children reject him for his presence and also for the imposition of Julian Albans, the richest and most popular child in the school. They'll only hang out with him summer Dawson and Jack. With the latter he has an initial estrangement when he makes a comment about August's appearance at the Halloween party, something Jack doesn't understand at first, but when the summer Halloween party makes a comment about Jack suggests he did the wrong thing and wants to improve things with August. After a brief suspension and an apology email, he and August reconciled just in time to do their science project. By the time he returns from the Christmas and New Year holidays, August's own annual hearing test shows he has impairment (very common in people with Treacher Collins), something he had already started to detect, so he starts wearing hearing aids, which first bother him but then bother them and even give him a more positive focus. Even other kids who didn't mix with him could start doing it and see his funny and funny character. But on a school trip August and Jack are attacked by seventh-grade students from another school. Things would have happened with seniors if another classmate, Amos, hadn't shown them get out there. In the tumult August is the spoils of the expensive hearing aids that his parents had received from him and that warned him to take care of him, which fills him with anguish. However, everyone understands the situation and becomes a popular child after the August incident and receives acceptance and respect from his own. Olivia via Pullman is august's older sister. Due to August's health problems, Via has been delegated by her family, though she learned to accept it and developed a special bond with her maternal grandmother, who had begun the novel four years ago. As he knows things would have been worse than that for August, he tends to keep his struggles to himself. Like her younger brother, Via is going through a new phase as she enters high school and discovers that her former elementary school friends, Miranda and Eva, have changed with her. Despite this difficult time, she sees that by making new friends and becoming support for August, it is also a new beginning for her to be encouraged to stay in school. Summer Dawson comes from a biracial family. His father was a soldier who died on duty, so he lives alone with his mother. Unlike most children who are related August, he accepts it from the beginning and doesn't make fun of him, proving a true friend to him. However August thinks summer is his friend just because the director asks him soon to see if he is honest and both become good friends. Jack Will is the son of a school teacher and social worker. He has a younger brother, Jamie. Unlike pullmans and Dawsons, his family has a tough financial situation so they can't afford certain things like a home of their own, a pet, a new computer or even a sledge, so Jack fixes an old sled he found on a hill to play with him. She finds it difficult to make friends since August because of her appearance and because she also wants popular children to consider it but her mother and many circumstances make her rethink about August and feel that her relationship with her is more important than having fake children. His family's financial problems and apparent lack of talent in certain disciplines mean that Jack has low self-esteem and sometimes August, who seems entherously to parents who love him, is a good student and gives him what he wants. However, the novel implied that Jack isn't as un-bright as he thinks. In fact, August makes him see that he's smarter than he thinks and if he's more confident in himself, he'd do better at school. Justin lives in Brooklyn and via boyfriend. He loves music, especially the zydeco4 genre, and knows how to play the violin. She is impressed by August's appearance, but at the same time is kind to her via and child. He suffers from ticks, which are sharp when nervous. One detail of its narrative is that it lacks capital letters at the beginning of the paragraph and for the names themselves. For Justin, being with pullmans looks in a real family is like something his parents can't enjoy since their parents and the relationship between them is strained. It also implied that her parents are careless with her. As she manages to see Via and her family's desire to protect her brother from Via's stress and any threat, even avoiding inviting her parents to participate in a play in which she will perform. At the same time, he also learns how Via was a friend of Miranda and speaks of how the latter august. Miranda Navas was a friend of Via from elementary school until before entering high school. During summer camp before high school, she tells young women who teach her how to make and interact with provocative attire and she in turn lies to give herself more importance to be more compassionate. One of them says August is his brother, because he is one of the few people outside him Which really appreciates August, with Dawson in the summer. After seeing her new exterior look and discovering that she likes and enjoys it, Miranda decided to share this change with Eva, because she knew she would accept it to a good degree unlike Via, which is more serious. She also decided to hang out with the boys considered popular and therefore stay away from Via, who lives the same. However, giving her joy away from this new stage gives Miranda more solitude because unlike Via and August she doesn't have a strong or affectionate family nucleus. Her parents divorced before entering high school and her father formed a family with her new partner, with whom she is expecting a child. Her mother is described as an affectionate woman. For him, getting away through and so august and Pullmans means walking away from people who have a genuine admiration for him. It is seen in the seventh part, where Miranda is the narrator and meets August again after several months. But there's also one character who will be hostile to the story: Julian Albans, who was Beecher's most popular child before august's arrival. She encourages the exclusion of other students toward August based on her estate. Similarly, it's the kids who have befriended August also rejected, as is the case with Jack, who gets beat to her August humiliation. Over time, students get sick of that situation, turn away from Julian, and start talks with August and Jack, realizing what August really likes. Finally, Julian's bad attitude towards August ends up costing him his popularity and his parents' decision to change his school for next year. As Julian is not a narrator, not only is his view of August largely unknown, but also his family life and interaction with others. However, it's clear how he works and thinks about August in his mother's email to Mr Tushman and as in the end, feeling defeated by August and losing his popularity, he prefers to go to another school where he might be the center of attention again. His version is later known in Julian's story. Mr Tushman is a figure of what is appropriate right. This narrative resource applies to those who have authority and who help a lot for the protagonist when he comes to them. Well, Mr Tushman acknowledges the first August because, from his academic point of view, he believes that everyone has the right to education. It can be tested when Melissa Albans, Julian's mother, writes to her by email that Beecher is not an involved school and that August should not therefore study there. Mr. Tushman replies that August is not Students with special needs and that is why there is no reason why they should be refused their stay in Beecher. That's how he wants to socialize with August for kids rather than marginalize him by his appearance. He also proves serious but generous to discipline, as the suspension choice for expulsion has shown when he would dictate bealing Julian rather than expelling him as rules in Beecher to suspend Jack for two days. Bullying, one of the topics in August's lessons, is a common problem in schools. Before enrolling her in Beecher, her father opposes the idea that August will be excluded, which happens in effect. Julian spread false rumors about August so no one talks to him except Summers and Jack. There's also Jack's comment on August's face, something that saddened him because he thought Jack was a real friend. However, as time goes by, other children realise what August is really like and what is said about that is not true. It does and the event with another school's seventh grader causes August's popularity to go up and fall to Julian until virtually no one deals with him. As for Jack, he realizes his mistake and after great effort, his friendship with him will come and even rescue him from insulting Julian. When the incident happens with the seventh group, August reveals that there are more children who hate him than to defend them. By doing so, he manages to earn everyone's appreciation. An extension The novel also has cultural references to film, music and literature. One of the most referenced is Star Wars, as this movie saga is August's favorite, though its taste for it diminishes as he matures emotionally. Another lion, the witch and C.S. Lewis's wardrobe, relates to the history of heptology Narnia, the sound of movie music and david bowie's space oddity, christina Aguilera's beautiful and Natalie Merchant's songs as wonder. I recommend reading the August lesson. It's a book full of values like loyalty, friendship and courage, but it's also about issues that are recurring like bullying. It is an ideal book for both a child and an adult. In addition, they can read the fellow books of August lessons, according to this list, although I repeat: they do not continue the August plot, they are other ideas of characters who were left outside the novel or did not fit within it.
