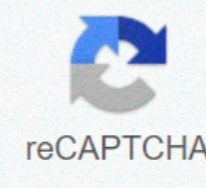

General Information: Sojourner Truth House (STH) is a 501(c) 3 non-profit organization located in Gary, Indiana and is sponsored by the Poor Servants of Jesus STH serves homeless and at-risk women and their children and underprivileged community members through three service streams.1. Customers staying at local shelters come to the day centre for benefits, referrals to community support agencies, community, training and professional training, health examinations and referrals, counseling and assistance with the search for housing.2. Once they have satisfactorily completed STH class programs and obtained housing, clients can maintain support through therapeutic programs and ongoing case management as members of the Transient Extension Program Participant (TOPPs) program. Community customers come to the food pantry to help meet the basic needs of the intermittent household. STH meets the needs of its customers with a holistic service delivery model that strengthens the mind, body and spirit of the customers we serve. Sojourner Truth House is a ministry of hope and help for homeless and at-risk women and their children sponsored by the Poor Servants of Jesus Christ. Through hospitality, advocacy, integrative services and collaboration, participants improve their quality of life and that of the community in a safe and confident environment. When homeless women and their children come to the Sojourner House of Truth, many are ashamed of their circumstances. Our staff greets them with a warm smile and a promise to always respect and honor their dignity. In the Sojourner House of Truth, we understand that these women have real barriers that must be faced head-on. With personalized case management and individualized definition of goals, we are able to determine the needs of participants and provide them with the means to overcome homelessness. Disclosure:O Disclosure Program was designed to address the spiritual, mental, social, financial and personal concerns of women who were homeless but who turned into their own homes. Many of these women suffered generational poverty, mental illness, substance abuse, domestic violence and/or personal tragedies. It is the goal of the Outreach Program to assist these women by equips them with the skills and resources needed to become self-reliant and become a positive contributing member of the community.
