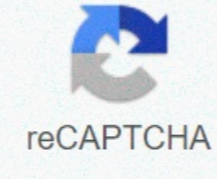

West point on the eno hours

This 404-acre park is located along a two-mile stretch of the picturesque Eno River, six miles north of downtown Durham. You can enjoy a leisurely picnic and walk around the grounds, or walk through the woods on one of the park trails. Download Trail Map here. Feel free to bring a canoe or kayak and experience the beauty of the Eno River. The park gates are open daily, all year round, from 8 .m - dark. History at West Point on Eno, a natural-historical city park, is located along a two-mile stretch of the picturesque Eno River. The 404 acres of forest, water and wildlife have changed little over the centuries since the area was home to the Shocco and Eno Indians. This river valley was also attractive to the first white settlers, primarily farmers and millers, who arrived in the 1750s to earn a living. West Point Mill of the thirty-two mills that once dotted the Eno River, no one has held as long and prominently in the history of this area as West Point Mill. Its location is in a great ford, accessible on roads from the north, south and west; His property is notable and influential people: Durham's rise in the south -- all together to give, this particular mill is a distinction, having functioned longer (1778-1942) and more prosperous than any other mill on the river. This mill has also become a vital center for a thriving community of about 300 families. There was a general shop, a blacksmith shop, cotton gin, a saw mill, and still is. In 1839, the mill even became the location of the post office. Because it was the westernmost point on the postal route from Raleigh to Roxboro, the name West Point was given to the post office, the mill and the community itself. The mill has ceased its in 1942, when a fresh-broke dam across the river, and the building collapsed from old age and neglect in 1973. Thanks to the use of photographs of the original mill, the remnants of the framing and the pristine foundation, the mill was reconstructed from materials gleaned from other local mills. Today West Point Mill is working again, grinding corn and wheat with power water. Stone flour and flour, along with other items, are sold in the mill shop. McCown-Mangum House in West Point, John Kabe McCown, the one-time owner of The West Point Mills, built this folk, Greek revival house as his residence in the 1840s. In 1891, the house was sold to Presley Mangum, an early Durham man who wanted to escape from the growing city of Durham. The Mangum family occupied the house until 1968. The renovated house has original fireplace and wooden works, including a shell room in the original heart of pine boards. The house is furnished and decorated in the style of the late nineteenth century, with several original works borrowed by the Mangum family. Next to the house is a garden of flowering shrubs, perennials, herbs and roses, representing the once extensive gardens of the Mangum family. Packhouse and Hugh Mangum Museum Photography One of the original buildings at West Point, Packhouse, once used for tobacco processing, now serves the Hugh Mangum Museum of Photography. In addition to the permanent exhibition of Hugh Mangum's images and equipment, the museum holds regular exhibitions of many of our regions' best photographers. The West Point Amphitheatre This secluded area, nestled in the woods, is the perfect place for company picnics, festivals, concerts, performances and other large group gatherings. For more information, visit the park's website. Picnic Services The Great Picnic Shelter was built to resemble the barn that once stood nearby. Featuring toilets, grills, and electricity, the facility can accommodate up to 75 people for group picnics and gatherings. The small shelter can accommodate up to 40 people and has a grill and drinking fountain nearby. For booking information, visit the park's website. Numerous picnic tables and grills are located throughout the park and are available for free on the first turn. The nature of the Trail, about 5 miles long, leads along the river and through rocky terrain with a granite bluff, often covered with mountain laurel rhododendron and partridge. There are also a variety of flowers, ferns and shrubs, finished in the mountains. The pleasant sequence of rapids and deep waters makes the river popular for rowing. Fishing is allowed; Catoma, bream, crappie, pickerel chains, and largemouth bass abound! In addition, Eno is the main habitat for red-eye or Roanoke bass, a fish found only in two rivers in the state. Eno and Tar. Several historical structures have been preserved on this site: West Point Mill is a reproduction of the colonial-era mill, which is now a museum. The Hugh Mangum Museum of Photography, located in a restored tobacco bag, contains historical photographs from the late 19th and early 20th century from the negatives found in the package, as well as the historic camera equipment, McCown-Mangum House - the home of one of the mill's owners, Restored 1850s house with late 19th century furniture, open to tours Other objects include: Amphitheatre - includes a large open field, lawn seating, stage, electricity, water, parking 5 miles of trails Picnic facilities Canoe access to the Eno River Natural Play Space - a play area for children's history Eno Indians first used the area for fish, hunting and crop cultivation. The arrows left behind by the tribe can be found today. When the white settlers came to the area, they noticed springs containing fresh water, which prompted them to invest in the construction of mills throughout the area. The first mill built in Eno was named Synott's Mill, which began working in 1752 by Michael Sinott, an almost legendary pioneer who had problems in his personal life and often appeared in court. Shortly after the death of Michael Synott in 1780, the area was acquired by William Thetford and Charles Abercrombie, who built the West Point Mill. While these mills produced the community began to build and became known as West Point. The community was successful for a period of time, but in the end all its inhabitants died out or moved on. West Point Mill served its owners for 160 years until it was shut down by a paratrooper named Jacob Eller returning from the war in 1942, the last mill on Eno to do so.
