Secondly, this machine has no more than 2.4 gallons of water at a time - 1.2 gal in a tank and 1.2 gal in a removable tank. The container simply lifts (straight up) its solidly cast handle, and it is almost impossible to set it back incorrectly after filling. You only carry 9.6 pounds of water to the unit, so practically anyone should be able to do this without any problems (right??). The manual warns to be gentle with an easy-to-operate valve opening and I had no problem filling the tank in the kitchen sink, although I had to tilt the tank at an angle to fit under the tap into my shallow sink. It still filled almost completely up to the top because there is a backstop halfway through the round filling, but sometimes there are dishes in the sink, so I fill a gallon of water jug and fill the tank and tank manually. I suggest you do not turn the filled container upside down until you are in the machine and ready to place the container on it, as there will be a few drops from the filling process itself. Placing the tank simply requires lowering it into the area where you removed it - nothing inconvenient. The device name has 8 gallons, which can be confusing. This is a 24-hour starting rating, NOT how much water it keeps, as I already told you it can hold 2.4 gallons. If you use the device with a max fan and one of the highest humidity settings and fill it more than 3 times, you have put about 8 gallons of water in the air during that time. Fan speeds are 3 and automatic setting, and you can set the desired humidity percentage every 25 to 65 times 5. Low is quiet, Medium (L2) is bearable, High (L3) is quite loud and I can't imagine sleeping with it. However, I have survived without having to use high speed and always use L1 at night. (My apartment is 700 SF and the device is located about 3 meters from the return of cold air to the oven.) The second part that makes noise is a set of about 12 glue-glue when water goes into the tank from the tank, on average for me every 15-30 minutes, in my opinion (plus or minus depending on setting, mine is always placed in the L1 fan) when it is running. In other words, once it has cycled away, it does not draw water during that time. I sleep with earplugs and when I fall asleep I can't hear it anymore, but it makes a sound that can disturb the light sleeper, so this can be a consideration of where you decide to place it. Mine's in the hallway, outside my bedroom door, which is always open. If you set it to 65, it will work continuously Manual. Otherwise, it will cycle on and off. I settled mine in 50 when I brought it home for the first 3 hours to increase humidity faster, but from then on I usually drive it at 35 at speed L1 (low) a few hours 40 before bedtime. In these settings I have to fill the tank and fill the tank once in the morning and again in the evening. You probably want to run your own experiments on your specific circumstances and wishes. The manual says it will automatically shut down if it dries, but I have not yet found myself in this situation. The filter came preinstalled, but installing a new one is easy. I bought an extra filter at Sears and paid \$17.99 for it. I've already left the filter after about a month, but I'm not sure if it was my fault or not. I bought the BestAir bacteriostatic water additive because of all the reviews I read about evaporative-type air weters (like this one), before choosing this model, saying it's necessary to use some kind of water conditioner to avoid the growth of nasty stuff that you then inhale, but I tried using tea tree oil halfway through. I didn't like the results, so I went back to the BestAir product, but I wondered if I affected the filter life using that oil? Another reviewer said they change the filter every month, so I'm not sure about this part yet. The last couple of things. The manual says it must be positioned so that it is at least 2 of any wall so that air vents can function correctly. Moistened air is released directly from the top of the appliance and also blows to the right. This unit has a humidity sensor, but it is only installed on the power cord from 5 or 6 units, and the manual says do not block it. I don't have a place. No matter what number you decide to set it to, if the wall causes the wrong humidity reading, so that the device does not moisten to the desired level, a simple fix would just be to put it in a larger amount. Sears sells an \$18.00 insurance policy for \$15,408, so if it stops working or develops a problem, Sears will give me a new one. Summary of first impressions -- I'm pretty happy with this unit (and still in 7 weeks). It is a whole house air wet and seems to work well in all the rooms in my 1 BR apartment in a dry winter climate. Why 4 stars, not 5? I would have liked to have seen greater water capacity and there is no tank at the bottom, as the water could potentially leak if the device is moved or messed up. I don't think I would put this unit on the carpet without putting it in some kind of tray or water barrier, especially if you have children or pets, because I'm pretty sure it could spill water if it's bumped hard enough.
