Usually, a set of sheets includes a mounted sheet, a flat sheet and 2 pillowboxes. Bedface went the other way. They offer 3 different sets to choose from. For our purposes, we reviewed the popular sleep set, which includes a mounted sheet, a duvet cover, and 2 pillowcases. These sheets are slightly thicker than most and are designed to become softer with each wash. The duvet cover has a case with concealed buttons for increased durability and a smoother aesthetic. The mounted sheet has an elastic band covering the ends of the mattress. The sides of the mounted sheet are similar to a flat sheet, which means that there is no elastic band running on the sides of the mattress. Finally, the pillowcases contain an envelope enclosure. This allows a tighter fit around the pillow, in addition to avoiding careless, extra fabric. These sheets are constructed of larger threads inside a looser tin, allowing for optimal breathing. bedface sheets Build Quality All, the bed sheets seem to have a good quality construction. I determine this by examining every inch of seams, the quality of the material, and the overall construction. After careful examination of these sheets, there were virtually zero free wires. The few loose wires that I found were easily removable. While not all of them could be removed from the set, the remaining few don't seem as if they would cause any kind of additional damage to the set. The pillowcases were impeccable, and the fitted sheet had a nice and comfortable fit around the mattress. bed-face sheets – king size on the platform bed (pamp, mounted sheet and pillowcases) Durability & Performance tests We tested bed-face sheets, focused on a few main points. For starters, contraction. The most common complaint about sheets tends to be shrinkage. There is nothing more frustrating than purchasing a new set of sheets just to watch it shrink drastically just a wash/dry cycle. Following the contraction is the examination of the thread. Are there loose wires? Have any loose threads become worse by normal use? Have new wires appeared after washing and drying the sheets? Finally, I test the colors/dyes used in sheets in materials of lower quality (run, bleeding, etc.). Test Shrinkage contraction tests are an essential part of the testing process. In order to measure shrinkage over the sheet set I started with taking measurements of the flat sheet and a pillowcase (before washing / dry cycle). These measurements will serve as my basis for comparison. Next, we run the sheets through a standard wash and dry cycle and take new measurements after the cycle is complete. After doing this, I compare the original measurements to the new set and determine the overall shrinkage after a wash/dry cycle. Bedface sheets showed some of the small contraction levels I've seen, but mostly small compared to other 100% cotton sets. The duvet cover decreased by 3.14% (compared to the original size), and the pillowcase decreased by 2.90%. Any contraction below 5% is good. Contraction test – the duvet cover decreased by 3.14% after washing/drying. Pillow face decreased by 2.90% after washing / dry. Damage Test Through this test i take a deeper look into the sheet set for any new or additional damage that could have been a normal use byproduct or standard wash/dry cycles. Upon further review, bedface sheets seem to have held up well. After my testing + washing/drying period there were no new problems among the existing loose sheets and wires did not increase in length. Color Test The color test is used to show any color/dye run off (if any) of the sheets. To kick this test off, I completely soak a pillow in warm water and allow the pillow case to fully absorb the water. Then I called any excess water with my hands. Right after, I place the pillow face on top of a bed of paper towels. Finally, I firmly press a rolling needle against the pillow case and examine paper towels for any kind of color run off. Bedsheets showed no signs of colour or colouring, indicating that they are made of quality dyes and cotton sheets. Most cotton sheets I tested are younger and very soft. In this case, the bed sheets are thicker than most and on a scale of 1-10, where 1 is the softest, these sheets land around a 4. Oddly enough, bedface is able to do this combination of work. With these sheets, I felt like and I was greeted by a more rustic but comfortable and lived in the feel. While it may sound strange, bedface sheets are quite comfortable, even if they are not as soft as the set of traditional cotton sheets. Close the sets of bed sheets, showing duvet, pillows, and mounted sheets Cooling was another bonus with this set of sheets. Simply having a 100% cotton design is a major factor in the cooling and breathability of this set. Cotton just does a good job of allowing air flow between the mattress and sheets. Last but not least, style. Style. style can seem like a small part of the pie, no one wants to spend a lot of money on a nasty sheet set (that I'm aware of). Come in, face the bed. With a litany of different colors and styles available, bedface is an excellent option for sleeping, which is looking to spruce up the look of their bedroom. During my test I reviewed their gray feathers and starlight white sleep set. Personally, I enjoyed having a white sheet mounted contrasted with a grey duvet cover and pillowcases. Aesthetically speaking, the bed face just crushes her in my opinion. There is a litany of color options, sizes, styles, and setting options. They have a set, color, style, and price point, which works for a wide range of sleepers. Should I buy the sheets on the bed? I would recommend bedface sheets to sleepers who: Want 100% cotton sheets - made of 100% cotton, these sheets have a nice feel, in addition to an increasingly soft feel with each wash. You want a slightly thicker set of sheets - bed sheets contain a slightly thicker construction than most sets of cotton sheets I have tested so far. The thickness of these sheets makes for a more welcoming and lived in the feel. In addition, they feel more durable. You want quality sheets - from head up, these sheets are built from very high end materials in addition to a solid build quality. I never once worried as if the sheets were going to hold up through a washing cycle or just by normal use. I feel thicker and more robust gives me a high degree of confidence in bedface.
