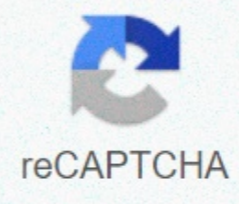

It also includes Associate's degree award programs offered by four-year colleges. It is headquartered in Jackson, Mississippi, and has more than 2 million members in more than 1,250 chapters, each of the United States, the U.S. Territories, the British Virgin Islands, the Marshall Islands, Canada, Germany, the Federated States of Micronesia, the United Arab Emirates, palau and Peru. [1] Phi Theta Kappa Mission Statement;[2] Phi Theta Kappa aims to recognize and encourage scholarship among two-year-old students. To achieve this goal, Phi Theta Kappa provides the opportunity to develop leadership and service, an intellectual climate for exchanging ideas and ideals, a living scholarship for researchers and an incentive to stimulate interest in continuing academic excellence. The name of origin and use of Phi Theta Kappa is a name similar, and is based largely on Phi Beta Kappa, which is an international honor agency for universities and traditional two-year colleges. Phi Beta Kappa presidents have spoken at the Phi Theta Kappa conventions, and the two societies have formed joint programs to encourage community and college graduates to pass on four-year institutions. The History Society was founded in 1910 by Stephens College, Missouri's two-year-old women's college under the name Kappa Phi Omicron. In 1918 it became known as Phi Theta Kappa and was organized nationally. In 1924, an amendment to the Constitution of society, which covered all two-year colleges, regardless of the same or co-education, was adopted. In 1929, the American Association of Junior Colleges formally recognized Phi Theta Kappa and became the official honorary association of two-year institutions. [4] It has been regarded as a respectable organisation that promotes service-oriented members in the community and more broadly. It is now considered the world's largest society of honour. (October 2015) (See how and when to remove this template message) The distinctive gold key membership pin was adopted in 1930 and is officially described as Phi Theta Kappa as follows: Key is a golden plate, keyed at the top and bottom. Throughout the center of the plate is a black enamel band on which three Greek stars appear, which are the initials of three mystical Greek words, meaning phronimon (Phi), thumos (Theta), katharotes (Kappa) and the meaning of wisdom, aspiration and purity. Behind the band is a wreath, on one hand made up of oak leaves, and on the other hand, laurel. The wreath of oak leaves represents the stability and strength of character, and curling leaves laurel means achievement and success. Above the band is the representation of the head of Athena, Goddess Learning; mysterious Greek stars appear on the base, which means light, light of learning and knowledge. Membership, according to Phi Theta Kappa, at the invitation, members pay a one-time international membership fee, plus any chapters or regional fees that may apply. Then, phi theta kappa member must maintain a high academic position, usually 3.0 GPA or higher, in order to remain a member in good condition. [1] Phi Theta Kappa members have the opportunity to receive some of the more than \$37 million in scholarships awarded exclusively to Phi Theta Kappa members. Members of the United States also have the right to participate in the All-USA Academic Team program, co-sponsored by USA Today, and expanding their statewide academic teams. Members will also receive automatic nominations for the National Dean's List and job posts only for Phi Theta Kappans. Finally, members have the opportunity to become elected chief civil servant, regional official and international official. All these leadership positions help students grow as professionals. It gives them the experience they will use as professionals in the future. [5] Phi Theta Kappans events participate in several gatherings each year, with the annual convention (also called Catalyst or International Convention) usually taking place in early April. There have been 92 international conventions for Phi Theta Kappa. International conventions take place annually in different regions of the United States. In 2008, about 3,000 Phi Theta Kappa members took part in a rally in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania. In 2009, the convention took place in Grapevine, Texas. About 4,000 Phi Theta Kappa members participated. The 2010 convention was held in Orlando, Florida with over 3,600 participants. The 2011 convention was held in Seattle, Washington, with more than 3,600 participants representing more than 500 chapters. The 2012 convention took place in Nashville, Tennessee, where 4030 participants. The 2013 convention was held in San Jose, California with 3,450 participants. The 2014 convention was held in Orlando, Florida, at Walt Disney World Resort, with a record 4,102 members. In 2016, the convention was held in National Harbor, Maryland, with 3,876 members from 591 chapters. In 2017, the 2017 centennial party was held at the roots of Phi Theta Kappa in Kansas City, Missouri. There were 4,141 members, thus setting a new attendance record. The 2019 Convention was held in Orlando, Florida, with 3,775 members and the upcoming 2020 Convention [9] The Phi Theta Kappans recognize the achievements of chapters for their work on the Honors-In-Action project and/or the college project, as well as recognition of recognized prominent chapter members, officers, officers, advisers and administrators. High scoring chapters are recognized as distinguished chapters. The annual convention also hosts the elections of five international officials. In addition to the annual convention, Phi Theta Kappans participates in the Phi Theta Kappa Honors Institute, which will be held in June for a generally week-long meeting. Although the oldest association of the society's alumni are college-based associations related to existing chapters, the final years of the twentieth century saw the development of regional alumni associations as a means of increasing the participation and support of alumni. Among them is Zeta in New York, the New York Alumni Association, which offers membership to Phi Theta Kappa Alumni living in New York or who are alumni of the New York chapter. 1996 under founding chairman Paul P.J. Cataline, Christopher Strang and Rebecca Chapin, of Zeta in New York, as well as other regional associations, have used a larger platform in the Regional Association to expand membership, increase programming and provide expanded support for the New York area and society. Since 1996, Zeta New York has grown from 10 members to nearly 1,000 members. The Association provides important annual scholarships to college students and helps the region by providing the annual convention, Honor's Study Weekend and Leadership Retreats each year. Years after Zeta New York chartered, other states and regions such as the Carolinas Region (Alpha Ohio, Missouri, Michigan, Nevada-California, New England, and Middle States have followed suit and transition to regional communities.
