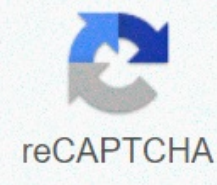

Fun Things to Do in San Diego For an unforgettable and varied trip, add the following activities in San Diego to your must-do list. The beer-making scene has exploded so much that San Diego is now using American craft beer what Napa and Sonoma are for American wine. With more than 100 breweries within the city limits, you can even enjoy your holiday around suds and hops theme. Make it a point to visit Strauss, Ballast Point, Lost Abbey and especially Stone Brewing Co.'s whimsical World Bistro & Gardens in Escondido. San Diego breweries run around Highway 78 (Hops Highway), along which small, independent microbreweries operate tasting rooms. On 30th Street (beer boulevard), pubs serve dozens of local beers, while the Mira Mesa neighborhood is home to excellent breweries such as Rough Draft and Green Flash. To best experience the city's thriving craft beer scene, book a Brew Hop tasting tour that takes you from Taproom to Taproom in safety and style. Go Diving NHANGLUYEN91 / Shutterstock If you're a dedicated diver, you probably already know about San Diego's Wreck Alley, an underwater treasure trove of sunken ships to explore. The 366-foot-long HMCS Yukon, a Canadian destroyer that turned into an artificial reef after its sinking, is 105 feet below sea level. Divers defy these depths to take a close look at the ship's old deck and turrets and swim through the light-flooded corridors. The sheltered la Jolla bay is another world-class dive site – its kelp forest is teeming with garibaldi, leopard sharks, bat rays and shellfish. If you're interested in what's underwater but prefer to stay up, La Jolla Cove is also a great place to snorkel alongside the seals. See whales In San Diego, don't forget that from mid-December to April, about 20,000 gray whales travel from Alaska to Mexico and back through these waters during their annual migration. If you're here between mid-June and September, you'll see blue whales instead – a group of at least 2,000 of these 100-foot-long giants that are frequented along the San Diego coast during the summer months. The view from the coast can be fantastic, but for a really exciting experience, board one of Hornblower's small boats or flagship for a harbour excursion where an experienced captain steers you towards this endangered giant. At SeaWorld, you can see captive orcas and belugas up close, and at the birch aquarium in Scripps, you can take a whale-watching tour with a marine biologist and then hang out in the aquarium to get to know other species of marine life. Much of San Diego is pretty spectacular, and its outdoor gems are best experienced at pace. The Hillside Presidio Park of the Old Town has the Junipero Serra Museum, where Father Serra founded the first Californian mission in 1769. Save up to 55 percent on many attractions, it advertises. It sounds almost too good to believe, so we set out to find out the truth about the smartphone discount pass. We poked, prodded, clicked, and looked at the fine print. We've even created a table to calculate the savings, all that so you don't have to. This will help you find out if it is a good idea for your holiday. If you tend to lose things (or forget to take them on a trip), the passport may not be for you. Lost passports are non-replaceable or refundable. Think of Go San Diego as a volume discounter. Passport providers negotiate with local tourist attractions for discounts and sell them as passport-based packages. You can choose from different types of Go San Diego: the basic version (all-inclusive) covers all the attractions offered by the pass at a fixed price, valid for a maximum number of days you choose. Buy more days, and the pass costs more. A built-up pass offers fewer attractions and is good for 30 days after its first use, but you can only choose the attractions you want to visit. The more you choose, the greater the discount. You can also choose from prefabricated packages for the most popular attractions. The California Explorer Pass offers you the possibility of 3, 4 or 5 attractions for a price. It's easy to use. Just take your printed or mobile Go Pass to one of the inclusive San Diego attractions, present it at the ticket window, and you're in. After it was used for the first time, the pass is good for the number of days you have chosen, but these must be consecutive days. If you skip one because you're tired, you don't get a refund or renewal. With the exception of the Multi-day passes you can visit each attraction only once. The passport will probably save you some money, but for most people it won't be as much as the ads claim. The only way to know for sure: Add it up. Only you know which attractions you want to visit and how much you are willing to rush them to pack everything. A quick way to get all the prices you need for this is to use the Go Select page where you can use it current prices. Go San Diego will save money if you: Buy a three-to-five-day pass and visit all the big-ticket attractions (SeaWorld, Legoland, San Diego Zoo and Safari Park) or visit three or four of the smaller attractions per day. Let yourself be realistic about how much you can do. The big attractions will last a full day at a time, and some are far apart. Other attractions that take less time can take significant travel times to get from one to the other. If you pack your schedule too tightly and pooped to finish them all, your savings will fall. Group your passport activities: You can use the rest of the trip for other things. If you're doing all the activities that are the top things to do in San Diego in three days, you could save nearly 40 percent, but you'd be so rushed that you don't have much time to enjoy them. Extend this to a more reasonable five-day period, and you'd save about 20 percent. Take seven instead, do nothing else, and the savings drop to just 5 percent. Of all California's top tourist destinations, San Diego has the most attractions that charge high ticket prices, with five of the top dozen attractions charging far more than 50 dollars per adult ticket and three others charging an entrance fee. These attractions are why most people visit the city, and if you plan to do them all, you'll probably use your pass a lot. However, not everyone wants to see the top sights, and these insights can help you make sense of everything. You may not be interested in some of the attractions on offer: for example, if you don't like going to museums, that takes about 20 attractions off the list. If you don't like guided tours, it eliminates another half-dozen. If the list of things you want to do becomes too small, the pass may not save you. However, some people say that it has introduced them to enjoy activities that they may not have found alone. And if you even break, you save on every little thing you do afterwards. Only longer passes include SeaWorld (three days or more). Take a closer look at this long list: You'll see that some attractions are not in San Diego, but in Anaheim, Orange County or even Hollywood. You would have to go there to enjoy what may or may not be part of your holiday plan. A museum-oriented, tour-oriented holidaymaker who won't leave San Diego has about two dozen attractions to choose from. Some attractions require reservations: After you have purchased the pass, you must Make reservations for some tours. Read all the details so you don't get disappointed. You can't buy a Go San Diego pass at the box office, so you need to plan ahead. But not too far.
