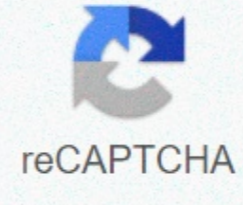

According to the comments section, an assigned area for the observer will sign along with the signatures of the child's parents to confirm that they have given permission to the observer and have been informed of the outcome of their child's observation procedure.
