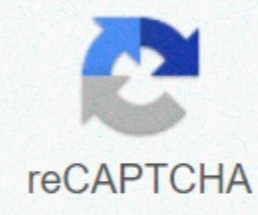

Canadian Press/Jonathan Hayward WINDSOR, ONT. -- The Greater Essex County School Board reported cases of COVID-19 at two of its schools on Monday. According to the GECDSB website, cases have been confirmed at Sandwich High School, Riverside Middle School and Tecumseh Vista Elementary. The letter, which informs the school community of the case, says there was a high-risk case at the school and they worked with the health unit to provide lists of staff and students to assist in contact tracing. The school remains open and the Windsor County Essex Health Unit will contact those identified as at risk of exposure to the confirmed case and give guidance to follow. Those with no contact have not been identified as close contact. A memo from Tecumseh Vista informing the community of a case of high-risk exposure says WECHU has not recommended any further action at school level. A case of high-risk exposure was reported in Riverside Sunday and Monday, a letter was issued making the school community aware of the cases. According to the school's website, it will remain open and all affected pupils and staff have been notified and follow wechu guidelines. All three schools encourage students and others to monitor covid-19 symptoms every morning with the Ministry of Health's COVID-19 screening tool and stay home if you feel sick. Two dozen pupils at St William's Catholic Primary School were released on Thursday following a confirmed case of COVID-19. The school remains open, according to a report on the Catholic Council's website. (Tinelli Choujkrat/Radio-Canada) Local Catholic and community school boards reported more cases and the risk of potential contact on Thursday. A cohort of 24 pupils at St's Catholic Primary School sent home to after a confirmed case of COVID-19 at the school, a news release from the Windsor-Essex Catholic District School Board Thursday states. The council says it learned of the incident Thursday afternoon and notified the affected students. The school, located in Lakeshore, remains open, according to a report on the council's website. The Windsor-Essex County Health Unit will be in contact with individuals who may have been directly affected and tell them the next steps, the release said. If parents do not contact the health unit, the exemption continues to be read, then they have not been identified as close contacts and their children can continue to attend school. The news comes after the health unit declared the Catholic Council's first outbreak at W. J. Langlois Catholic Elementary School on Thursday, with about 20 students and staff sent home to be isolated. It is a list of cases confirmed by outbreaks and rejected classes as of Friday on the website of the Windsor-Essex Catholic District School Board. (Jennifer La Grassa/CBC) Another public council school sees a case in which Tecumseh Vista Elementary School under the Greater Essex County School Board reported the case to COVID-19 on Thursday. In a letter to parents on Thursday, the school said it was alerting the community to a high-risk case. A health unit will contact anyone who is close contact with the case, the report said. This comes after a week of cases and closures in the community council, with Frank V. Begley experiencing the region's first COVID-19 outbreak, forcing the vacation of the entire school community. COVID-19 reported at tekumshe Vista Academy - Elementary. According to the Greater Essex County School Board website, there is one confirmed case at the school at 11665 Shields St. The school remains open and a notice posted on the council's website says all affected students and staff have been notified and are following the instructions of the Windsor-Essex County health unit.
