C major and C minor are common strings that start early because they are extremely easy to teach when you focus on finding it in piano and play without factoring in reading notes. Well... that's where these worksheets come in! They'll help your students read the notes, too! Each worksheet has a similar teaching method, so I'm going to give step-by-step instructions on how to teach the C Major worksheet and then, if you want to listen to my silly teaching skills for others, watch the video lab covering each sheet! (Start the video at 8:51 to learn the C minor worksheet. Start the video at 2:05 p.m. for the extra track). How to teach the C Major Chord Worksheet: Step 1: Start by teaching your students how to find the C chord on the piano. Once they know how to play it, then you can insert the worksheet that shows them how it looks in scores with real notes! Step 2: Explain to them that the movement they made with their right hand is how it looks in scores and then allows them to spot the treble clef C important string. Do the same thing on the bass clef! Step 3: Ask them how it translates to NoteMatch! Start with their color on the NoteMatch paper worksheet and then on the real-life NoteMatch. They're going to love coloring! Step 4: Now it's time to have your students analyze the piece! Ask them how many C-strings they see and count them out! Then explain the difference between blocked and rolled C strings and measure the bass clef C strings. In their minds, it starts to make sense and doesn't seem so overwhelming, but it's reading notes fully and understanding it! Step 5: Time to hit the keys and start playing!
