The minivan segment, with recent redesigns of both the Honda Odyssey and Toyota Sienna, predicts that price pressures will increase on Chrysler and Dodge minivans, which are segment volume leaders. A constant small base of buyers and extremely stable and low gasoline prices mean that there will be lower price pressures for premium brand hybrids such as the Ford 2011 Lincoln MKZ Hybrid and Toyota's 2011 Lexus HS 250h. Meanwhile, buyers should expect nothing but firm pricing for the latest high-end electric cars such as the Nissan Leaf and Chevrolet Volt plug-in hybrid gm TrueCar, RydeShopper and CarsDirect - the best way to see the lowest car prices in your area. Also note that wooden and metal garage doors can be transformed with paint work, which is much cheaper than replacement. One of the biggest variables in garage door costs is in the materials used.
