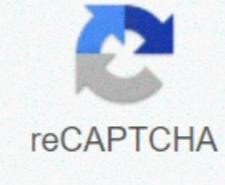

Most students are required to take at least five Regents exams, which measure students' achievements in high school level options. These required exams include English arts, mathematics, science, social studies and an additional exam regents. There are three times every year when students can take regency exams -- January, June and August.As schools move to a new curriculum for global history and geography and U.S. history and government disciplines, there are two different testing options offered to New York students in these subjects in 2020 -- framework and basic curriculum. Here's the 2020 regents' exam schedule, according to the New York State Department of Education website. 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At a July meeting, New York State Department of Education officials discussed a process that will review the options for diplomas. To recommendations on diploma options, a committee is expected to be this fall, with a final report submitted to the Board of Regents by autumn 2020.Once formed, the committee would make recommendations to review current diploma requirements, ensure that all students have access to multiple graduation pathways and recommend a transitional plan calendar that allows times to prepare for and implement changes. This would include current or recent parents, students, educators, researchers, lawyers, higher education and business leaders.
