TOEFL began development in 1962 and was first awarded two years later. The aim is to prepare international students to study in english-speaking countries or programs. That said, it can be very challenging because you only get one crack at hearing and understanding what participants in conversations and lectures have to say. You'll have six individual tasks to do, so space for errors is limited. The six tasks include four integrated and two independent. In a unified task, you should read a short excerpt, listen to an educational lecture or conversation about campus life, and formulate your answers by bringing together appropriate information from textual and oral sources. You will also be asked to listen to academic course lectures or campus life and respond to questions about what you hear. You will be evaluated about how well you are you able to synthesize and effectively communicate material from listening and reading portions. For independent assignments, you will be given an opinion question on a familiar subject. Here, you will be printed on how well you can speak spontaneously and coherently communicate your ideas. TOEFL: Write, the last 50 minutes, and for many of the strictest, part of the TOEFL Test is the Writing section. While you'll only have two tasks – the fewest of any section – you'll also only have 50 minutes to complete which can run guickly when engaging in writing older forms.
