As per request here is a video on how I did it. :0) You will need: A bottle bleach water spray a Stencils bowl (if desired) Spray paint (Optional) Gloves and a mask and a well ventilated area. Take your spray bottle and fill it halfway with water and halfway with regular household bleach Pour your stencil into your shirt (I used stones to weigh mine since I just ate cardstock for my stencils) Start spraying the way you want, start with bleach or spray paint, invent it as you go. Once you feel it's finished and the bleach set to a color you like, grab the shirt and dip it in a bowl of clean water. Twisting it, let it dry (If you plan to make the back of the shirt, otherwise just go ahead and wash) When washing: Wash the shirt by itself with little laundry detergent, the first time, then dry. I can't emphasize that enough Wash. Own. It's the first time! Otherwise, you run the risk of ruining your other clothes. After washing it and sedoing it once, then you are well to wash with other clothes. I hope you all like this Instructional and have some use of it. For example, I have a guy for whom you need a gift. Just do it. They are amazing gifts to give, and you can put most of any project on it. :0) This is a tutorial on what you need and how to lighten your own t-shirt to make a unique and cool style.fill your small dish with bleach and continue to paint it design on the black t-shirt (dark colored t-shirts work well too) It will take a while for the bleach to appear for it to be patient. You may have to wait or guess where you put the next line depending on your style (depending on the thickness you put in the bleach 30 seconds- 2 minutes) Make sure that you are working in a well ventilated area and have cloths in which you don't mind getting some bleach stains. Once you have your design turned on and want to add more effect around it to make it interesting, you can use the spraying method. You will need to put 2:1 bleach into the water solution in the empty spray bottle. then to cover your artwork make a stencil with adhesive tape and place on top of already drawn pieces. (Wherever you put the tape there will be no bleach points. Now stay a few feet away and give him one or two good sprays. After it has dried for a few minutes and the dots appeared you can remove the tape. but be very careful to first clean the bleach that has pudded up the tape if you don't want drops dripping down your shirt (but it looks pretty cool if right). Allow to dry for about half to an entire hour, then rinse in cold water and allow to dry. Now you are ready to wear your amazing new t-shirt! Good luck! P.S. for variation you can make a stencil with adhesive tape and then use the spray method to fill it. You may also want to wash this yourself for the first few times. Hair bleach contains hydrogen peroxide and bleaching powder. When the bleach is mixed, it starts to oxidize immediately. This causes it to lose its strength and effectiveness. Mixed bleach that is left over cannot be used and should be eliminated. Some brands of bleach may last longer after the bleach has been mixed, as the ingredients differ from one manufacturer to another.
