Fortunately, a cast of supporting players including Sam Rockwell and Maya Rudolph are on hand to help him. **WATCH NOW** The Talented Mr. Ripley, 1999 Anthony Minghella's gorgeous, black-hearted adaptation of Patricia Highsmith's novel is one of the best thrillers of all time, and his sun-wet Italian vistas contradict the darkness of his story. Matt Damon plays Ripley, a chameleon con man whose obsession with Jude Law's rich playboy becomes deadly. **Watch now** Grease, 1978 summer lovin', you have an explosion with a clock of this perene musical fave, based on the 1971 Broadway show of the same name. Set at a fictional high school in the summer of 1958, Grease follows an ensemble of teenagers led by the good girl Sandy (Olivia Newton-John) and Greaseres Danny Zuko (John Travolta), whose supposed summer adventure becomes more complicated after arriving unexpectedly at the same school. **WATCH NOW** Clueless, 1995 Amy Heckerling's shave-ship and the winsome modernization of Emma's Jane Austen gets just better and better with age, as does Alicia's lightning-in-one-bottle performance as Cher Horowitz, cinema's most benevolent popular girl. Although the film takes place technically over several seasons, its Beverly Hills setting makes the whole vibe deeply summery. **WATCH NOW** Jaws, 1975 Steven Spielberg loved shark thriller barely needs an introduction. Their attempts to move on to Bernie (Terry Kiser) as yet alive are just the ridiculous, ridiculous iceberg comedy tip. **Watch now** doing the right thing, 1989 Spike Lee's live and vibrant masterpiece is a device on the best movies of all time lists. Keaton as two older singles falling for each other, despite their apparent differences. WATCH NOW What About Bob?, 1991 An Excellent Holiday Nightmare Movie, What About Bob? Stars Bill Murray as a needy psychiatric patient who follows his selfish psychiatrist Dr. Marvin (Richard Dreyfuss) on vacation. Even worse-he gets along famous with Marvin's whole family. WATCH NOW River Wild, 1994 This adventure thriller stars Meryl Streep and David Strathairn as an quarreling couple whose trip rafting on white water with their children takes a dramatic turn when faced with two dangerous criminals (Kevin Bacon and John C. WATCH NOW And Confused, 1993 One of Richard Linklater's oldest offerings, this 1970 stoll-in-the-comedy coming-of-age follows a sprawling ensemble of Texas teens through during their last day of school. Of course, his former (played then-relative newcomer Kristen Bell) is there too, alongside her new beau rockstar (Russell Brand), and the resulting hijinks. WATCH NOW Sandlot, 1993 Another perfect summer sports movie, Sandlot tells a touch-of-age story centered around Little League baseball. Shy fifth grader Scotty (Tom Guiry) initially has trouble making friends in his new city, but is soon taken in times by a local baseball team.
