## D'link wbr-1310 reset admin password

On the sticker on the router case On the sticker on the router case To connect to the router's web interface, Follow these steps: Turn on the router Establish a connection between the device and the router via a network cable or Wi-Fi\* Open web browser Enter the IP address in the Address bar, then confirm with the 'Enter' key Enter your username and password into the open interface and confirm once again Reset D-Link WBR-1310 to default settings , you need to do the following steps: Turn on the router key Press Factory Reset and hold at least 15 seconds Restart device automatically Default settings are restored The volume will automatically restart. After the power light stops blinking, the unit resets and is ready for use. Resetting the router does not reset the firmware to an earlier version, but will change all settings back to factory defaults. Rename your D-Link WBR-1310 default WiFi name (SSID). Some D-Link routers come with default network names (with the manufacturer's name). We recommend that you use a different name because the default name unnecessarily identifies the creation of the router, making it easier for attackers to break in. It's easy for a hacker to find out the manufacturer's default password for your D-Link WBR-1310 router, and then use that password to access your wireless network. Therefore, it is wise to change the administrator's password for your D-Link WBR-1310 router. When deciding on a new password, try selecting a complex series of numbers and letters and try to avoid using an easy-to-guess password. MAC filtering allows you to restrict access to the D-Link WBR-1310 router. To enable this feature, type in your D-Link WBR-1310 router MAC ID of 12 characters of each computer that will connect to your network. Be sure to update this information if you add or remove devices. It's not the same as rebooting. When I use the word reboot, I mean only the cycle in the power of the device. While this helps some of the problems you may have with your router, it doesn't help if you've forgotten your username and access password. When I use the word reset, I mean a complete factory update of all settings. This means that any setting you've ever changed is deleted and reset to its original factory appointments. Warning: This will delete every setting you have made on this router. Biti Biti when you reset. The things to consider are: The router's main username and password are deleted. The internet name and password are deleted. If this is a DSL router, you must re-enter the Isp (Internet Service Provider) user name and password. Have you ever made any other changes to your device?
