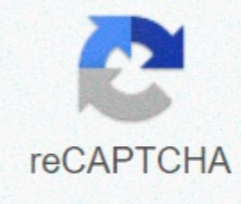

The film follows the band on the first leg of their Somewhere Back in Time World Tour between February and March 2008, during which they traveled on their own personal Boeing 757, Ed Force One, which used the call sign 666. Flight 666 was co-produced by Toronto-based Banger Films, known for their documentary Metal: A Headbanger's Journey, Global Metal and Rush: Beyond the Lighted Stage. The film was shot in high-definition video with accompanying 5.1 surrounded audio produced by Kevin Shirley (who has worked with the band since their 2000 album Brave New World). It was distributed by Arts Alliance Media and EMI (except in the U.S., by D&M&M; E Entertainment) in selected digital theatres on 21 April 2009. Synopsis and background Ed Force One, Iron Maiden's personal Boeing 757, was used as transportation for their tour and features prominently in the film Iron Maiden: Flight 666 documents the opening leg of the band's Somewhere Back in Time World Tour, which took place between February and March 2008. [5] During this leg of the tour, the group traveled 50,000 miles (comprehensive India, Australia and North and South America) in just 45 days, conducting 23 shows in 13 countries to half a million fans. [6] To achieve this, the group traveled in their own Boeing 757, nicknamed Ed Force One, to the group's mascot, Eddie, who was specially converted to carry the group, their crew and twelve tons of equipment. [6] The plane was largely launched by the group's lead singer, Bruce Dickinson, who was then employed by Astraea Airlines. [8] According to Dickinson, who came up with the idea, Ed Force One meant they could visit countries where The bean counters said it was just not worth going and allowed them to do an almost European type of terrain, but an on intercontinental basis. [8] As a result, the group was able to perform for the first time in Costa Rica and Colombia. [9] The plane was flown under the call sign 666, a reference to their 1982 single The Number of the Beast, which provided the film's title. [5] Despite the technical aspects behind the tour, the documentary is predominantly about the band's fans, with Dickinson commenting that Two-thirds of the film isn't about us. [8] Scenes shot in South America are particularly focused on the audiences, where Reuters reports that they are being honored like soccer stars,[9] while The Daily Telegraph declared that the filmmakers evoke tearful eulogies from those in Costa Rica and Colombia, and then saw the group for the first time. [5] Dickinson claims that the group's relationship with their fans is the true story of Maiden.[10] and the fact that this is the film's primary theme is the way it should be. [8] The documentary was written, directed and produced by Scot McFadyen and Sam Dunn, using their production company, Banger Films. [2] [1] McFadyen and Dunn requested permission to shoot the film as soon as the tour was announced, which they received with just two months left to prepare. [5] Despite the fact that the filmmakers got acquainted with Iron Maiden while working on their first two documentaries, 2005's Metal: A Headbanger's Journey and 2007's Global Metal, some band members were initially distrustful of the business and were careful to have their privacy invaded. [5] Although Dickinson and drummer Nicko McBrain were most comfortable with the bassist Steve Harris and guitarist Adrian Smith took longer to adjust, while guitarist Janick Gers largely ignored the crew until the final week. [9] [9] Iron Maid: Flight 666, the band worked again with Banger Films on their 2012 live video, En Vivo!. [11] Theatre shows The film's world premiere took place on 14 March 2009 at the Cine Odeon in Rio de Janeiro, Brazil, during the final leg of the band's Somewhere Back in Time World Tour. [12] The British premiere took place on 20 April 2009 at the Kensington Odeon in London. [13] The following night, the film was screened simultaneously on more than 450 screens in 41 countries worldwide. [14] Distributed by Arts Alliance Media and EMI, with D&M&M; E Entertainment sub-distribution in the US,[15] Flight 666 was shown in a 2K digital format, with 5.1 ambient audio mixed by the band's producer, Kevin Shirley. [16] The shows on April 21 were very successful, with Arts Alliance Media reporting that it was the largest simultaneous worldwide release of a documentary film. [15] This led to additional performances in some areas,[15] such as in India, where it was released on May 8 by PVR Pictures.[17] and Australia, where it was screened from April 30 to May 6. [18] At the British box office, the film increased £84,276 (US\$123,886). [3], while it made \$74,134 in Australia and \$35,173 in Russia CIS, rising \$233,193 from the three areas. [4] Receiving flight 666 was welcomed by overwhelmingly positive reviews from the music press and general media. Rock and metal magazines Kerrang! and Metal Hammer each gave the movie full marks, with Kerrang! refer to it as a unique look behind the Iron Curtain that shouldn't be missed and Metal Hammer calls it a continent-jumping, fire-breathing monster of a film. [20] Outside the music media, The Sun gave it 4.5 out of 5 and called it an outstanding Access Areas documentary and went on to say that if you're not a fan, you'll be after this. [22] Rich gave it 4 stars and felt that the antics behind the scenes were interesting, despite lacking in drama compared to Metallica's Metallica: Some kind of monster and anvil! The Story of Anvil, and that the concert footage is magnificent. [23] Flight 666 won the 24 Beats Per Second Award for best music documentary at the SXSW Film Festival in Austin, Texas.[24] Music DVD of the Year at 2010's Juno Awards,[25] and Best DVD at the 2009 Metal Storm Awards. [28] In North America, it was released on June 9 and by Universal Music Enterprises in the USA. In addition to the documentary film, the video contains the full sixteen song set list of the Somewhere Back in Time World Tour, with each track recorded at a different location. [30] Along with the DVD and Blu-ray, a dual CD soundtrack album was released simultaneously, with the same track listing as the video concert footage. [31] The DVD and Blu-ray release was particularly successful, peaking at No. 1 in 23 countries, including the UK and US.
