When you get a driver's license in Florida, you have to take a driving test. The most common question we get about driving testing is exactly what will I be tested on? Is. Road testing is not required when Florida learners get a permit or limited license. When you get permission from students who are required to take a Drug and Alcohol Traffic Training course and DMV Permit Test.
