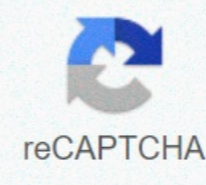

## Wool cloth farming

Hillsbrad Foothills - Wool Cloth Wool Cloth Item Level: 15 Where to Farm: Duskwod or Hillsbrad Foothills Recommended Level: 21+ Wool Cloth is the second fabric type in World of Warcraft. Wool is usually sold for between 10-20 gold per pile! Wool farming is one of the best ways to make gold at low levels. It can be planted around level 25. Most of the humanoids who dropped Wool were between levels 21 and 28. Look for worgens, skeletons and ogre. Update: You can make a lot of gold with Wool, but if you want to step up and make thousands of golds you should read my personal favorite guide. Where is the Wool Alliance Farm If You're Alliance heading to Stormwind and then heading south-east to Duskwod where you'll find the most Wool Cloth of almost any zone. There are 5 different places worth cleaning, you can go from one to the other killing all the humanoids on site while collecting wool. Hordes If you horde head to Hillsbrad Foothills and look for humanoids including ghosts, worgens and yeti. There are many different areas worthy of wool farming here: Tip: Have you ever wondered how players have so many 85 levels or how they can level 85 so quickly? I use and highly recommend the in-game Zygor leveling addon that will allow you to level up in 5 days of playtime. You can find the free version here. Note: To maximize all gold making strategies in WoW, I used the Gold & Addon Guide/addon, Zygor Auctions. I don't usually recommend farm fabrics for cash, there is usually a much better chance at some level. One exception worth noting is the woolen fabric. You may have noticed that woolen fabrics sold for a fairly crazy amount of gold per pile, especially on the side of the horde. The price of 10 gold or more for piles is not uncommon, and I have sold stacks for 20+ gold each. Yes, it's more than 1 g per fleece. It's usually cheaper on the alliance side, though. But even if you only get 3-5 g per pile on the alliance side, it is worth farming. Given that you can farm woolen fabrics as early as level ~18, and gain experience while doing so, it beats almost everything else in the initial level. I also like to farm things like wool because it doesn't require a profession. (Although wool can be skinned from sheep. Bet you don't know!) Why is wool so expensive? Because it is very difficult to find in meaningful quantities. Woolen fabrics are used to improve tailoring and first aid, and have few small uses in blacksmithing and engineering. Since most players will improve their first aid, they will use a woolen cloth that Gather for that purpose. So don't go to the auction house. It is also used in the search for fabric donations, which gives XP and reputation. Anyone who wants to do all the turn-in wool will need 15 stacks. In addition, woolen fabrics only descend from the mass around the level of 15-26, and not many players stay and farm for long at that level to create the main supply of this fabric. The difference between the Alliance and the Hordes There seems to be more masses in the alliance zone dropping woolen fabric, than in the gang zone. But the main reason cheaper on the alliance's part may be: The Stockade. Located in the centre of Stormwind City, many groups will run it, encouraged in it, and some high-level players will go there and farm for wool. The Horde does not have a comparable opportunity, which makes it more difficult to farm on the side of the horde. However, prices are usually much higher as well, so it may be more profitable for the hordes anyway. So where did you go to the farm wool? I've been researching this thoroughly. I believe this is the best farm place. Darkshore - Hordes & Mafia Alliance to kill: Twilight Disciples etc. I mention this not so much because it is the best farm place for wool - no - but because it is the best lowest level farm place. & Horde: The alliance can come here at levels 17-18 and kill the masses. Not much but they respawn quickly. In patch 3.2 a normal seat can be purchased at level 20, and this is also a great place to get gold for that seat. You need 5 total golds for skill and sitting, and you have to get them easily here before level 20. The hordes had to run there from The Barrens through Ashenvale. See map below. Alliance, will take a boat to Auberdine from Stormwind or Azuremyst Isle (outside Exodar) or Tel'drassil. Ashenvale – Alliance Only This is my favorite farm spot for woolen fabrics, no bars. Mass to kill: shaman abandoned etc. You can kill all the masses left in the area. Pay special attention to the shamans who have a fair chance to drop low-level herbs, which are quite valuable since the inscription. Ashenvale - Horde Only Horde's place in Ashenvale is not as good, but it is still worth it. Masses to kill: Laughing sisters, protectors cenarian The Barrens - Hordes Only Mafia to kill: Bael'dun Excavator etc. Mining nodes also lay eggs in this area. Redridge Mountains Mobs to kill: Blackrock Gladiator etc. Kill the highest level blackrock mafia you can find in this place. The ~20 mass level does drop the woolen fabric, but not as much as the level of 24-25. The Stockade – Alliance Only This is not my preferred way to get woolen fabric at all. Why? Because you have to be a higher level for that solo, and on a higher level there are better things to do for gold. Remember: farming woolen fabric is a gold tip of the lower middle level. However, if you need it and do not want to This is the fastest place to farm. Best auction is to sell it on AH in 20 stacks. Watch the price for a while and see what the highest price point seems, and sell later. Feel free to buy people who sell too cheap. Not the best place, but at least you'll have the masses for yourself. Deadmines Almost all humanoids drop wool here at a good rate. Darkshore Dark Strand Mass (Level 14) - around tower of Anthalaax Duskwod Skeletal mobs 25) [[20.48]] - Raven Hill Hill East twilight grove. Hillsbrad Foothills The Farmers, Footmen and Peasants (Level 24) [[33.49]] - West of Tarren Mill. Mass Syndicate (Level 20) [[76.47]] - Durnholde Keep, SE of Tarren Mill. Shadow Fang keeping most of the humanoids here will drop the wool, not the best place, but at least you'll have the masses all to yourself. Silverpine Forest Rothide Mass (Level 18) - Fenris Isle Stonetalon Mountains Harpies (Level 27) [[37.67]] - Charred Vale Windshear mobs (Level 22) [[73.58]] - Wind Shear Crag (The Venture Co mboardsund here does not have a good rate of decline, so stick to the Mass Windshear) Mass Kolbold (Level 17) - Boulderside Ravine The Stockades Probably the best place in the game for wool farming. As a Horde, you will die several times getting here, but it is worth it if you are after a lot of wool. This is a tedious example, but the masses have a good level of respawn. So by the time you have cleared the instance all the masses except the boss will be respawned and you can just start cleaning it again straight away. Suggest you be at level 50+ to make life easier and faster, otherwise it won't be worth the time. A clear run generally netted me about 60-80 tweeds and it took me about 20-30 minutes to clean up.
