Family Life Chaplain Training Centre is a resource agency for the chaplain-led family ministry. The main responsibility of the centre is to offer training opportunities and resources for chaplains on marriage programs and family counseling and enrichment. The centre houses a library of books and videos addressing various Family issues. The centre offers limited pastoral counselling by reference from the chaplains unit. Training conducted by Family Life Chaplain includes: Children in the middle: Second Wednesday and every month, 8 a.m.m until noon. It is a four-hour program that teaches divorced or separated parents how to help them face divorce. This course, or one like that, is mandatory for anyone who continues to divorce in Texas. Applied Suicide Intervention Skills Training (ASIST): ASIST is a two-day suicide intervention training program featuring basic intervention skills. It is designed to be the next step in the growth of prevention programs and military intervention. Participants attended two full days of training, including suicide factual modules, carer attitudes, risk estimates, suicide intervention skills training and suicide resources in the community. The crisis hotline is an emergency service available 24/7. Chains are in place to help people in extreme emergencies. On-duty chaplain can help with the abuse of couples, soldier deaths or family members, serious illnesses and suicide intervention. Counselling: FLCTRC provides individual counseling, couples, married and Family counseling to the Fort Hood Community. It is a training centre focused on providing the best, most recent and professional care in a confidential and safe environment. Family Wellbeing: 11:30 .m 1 p.m. Tuesday. This programme focuses on developing skills in parenting, family communication, changing management and values within the Family. It is open to and suitable for single and biennial families. Lunch is available. Marriage 101: 9 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. The first Wednesday of the month. The program provides couples who are committed to specific communication skills and strategies to help them understand each other and strengthen or restore their friendship. Completion of the course is required to use the Fort Hood church for weddings. Lunch is available. Pastoral Counselling: Fort Hood chaplains provide personal, wedding and family counseling. These counselling is offered in the context of religious and spiritual values. Appointments are arranged by calling your unit's chaplain office. Counselling is considered to be special information and is kept confidential. References: Chaplains often work alongside other assembly agencies, including Army Community Services, healthcare professionals, Social Work Services and Lawyers Advocate Judges staff. Chains can provide critical links between Soldiers or Family Members and these agencies. The Fort Hood Catholic Women's Army Council (MCCW) is dedicated to bringing community women closer to church and Christ through prayer studies, fellowship, Bibles and books, which meet the needs of the Fort Hood community and parish program. MCCW holds weekly meetings, starting with Rosary 9:30 to 11:30 a.m. every Wednesday at Comanche Chapel. All women of society are invited to join us. Free childcare for children 5 and under. In addition, the ceremony met from 6:30 to 8:30 p. m. Monday on the 58th Street Chapel (58th Street and Battalion Avenue). There is no childcare for the afternoon meeting. Their main Bible study is in the E335 Corps Headquarters Room. Unique to the Army is the availability of religious ministries at unit level. Each Soldier has a Team Of Ministry of Units (UMT), comprising chaplains and chaplain assistants, providing counselling, religious activities and spiritual care. UMT goes where soldiers go. They accompany their units to the field, PT formations, dining at dining facilities and visiting work areas. UMT's care about Soldiers. UMT shares army experiences and lives with Soldiers: heat, cold, hunger, cruelty, mud - they are all part of UMT jobs. A post-Sunday wide school meets at the Comanche Chapel (at Tanker Boulevard west of Clear Creek Road) 9:30 to 10:30 a.m. every Sunday. For more information, call 254-288-6545. Fort Hood churches are available for weddings and can be used by Soldiers and other members of the Army family at no cost. All marriages must have a sponsoring military chain, and all individuals are responsible for verifying bookings with their respective NCOIC churches. Fort Hood church policy requires all married couples at the Fort Hood church to complete a premature workshop provided by the Family Life Chaplain Training Centre. A marriage license can be obtained from the Bell County connection office or the Coryell County connection office.
