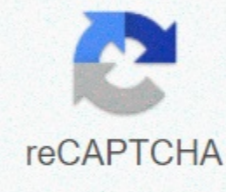

Here are some basic instructions for planting productive and ornamental plants in a garden of all sizes. Fruit trees can be both productive and decorative. Think about the size before buying a tree. If you want to grow productive trees in a small space (unless you have a large garden), choose dwarf varieties or plants that are grown into dwarf roots. You save time by climbing up the ladder to pick fruit or prune wood as well. Good choices include citrus fruits, apple trees, mangoes, avocados, pears, peaches and apricots. Fruit trees can be complicated to care for in an orchard or where production is the number one goal, but general care and management of a medium-sized backyard is much easier. Usually prune fruit trees after they have produced a crop. And always remove idioors or dead, sick or broken branches as soon as you notice them. Whenever you buy a fruit plant, check if a pollinator is needed. Many fruit trees bear fruit only if there is another variety nearby that provides cross-pollination. A simple way to cross-pollination is to skein two varieties for one plant. You may have accidentally eaten a wasp if you like this fruit. Fruit.
