Virgil was born on October 15, 70 B.C.E. in northern Italy in a small village near Mantua. He attended school in Cremona and Mediolanum (Milan), then went to Rome, where he studied mathematics, medicine and rhetoric, and finally graduated from Naples. He entered literary circles as Alexandrian, the name of a group of poets who inspired the demanding work of The Greek poets of the third century, also known as Alexandrians. In 49 BC Virgil became a Roman citizen. After studying in Rome, Virgil is said to have lived with his father for about 10 years, engaged in agricultural work, studied and wrote poems. After the Battle of Philippi in 42 B.C.E. Virgil's property in Cisalpine Gaul, was confiscated for veterans. In the following years Virgil spent most of his time in Campania and Sicily, but he also had a house in Rome. During the reign of Emperor Augustus, Virgil became a member of his court and was promoted by a minister, Maecenas, a demartist of

the arts and close friend of the poet Horace. He gave Virgil a house near Naples. Between 42 and 37 B.C.E. Virgil composed pastoral poems, known as Bucolic or Eclogues, and spent years on the Georgics. For the rest of his life, from 30 to 19 B.C., Virgil devoted himself to The Aeneid, the national epic of Rome, and the glory of the Empire. Although ambitious, Virgil was never really happy about the task. Virgil died 19B.C. Throughout his life Virgil was a poet and, as far as we know, had no interest in pursuing another career. He was born Publius Virgilius Maro in 70 BC near Mantua in northern Italy. His parents, the owners of agriculture, were people with property and substance, if not wealth, and were able to obtain a first-class education for their son. After completing his education, he returned home and possibly began working on the Ecloques, which appeared between the years 42 and 37 BC. In 41 BC, Emperor Octavian (later Augustus) confiscated the property of the Von Virgil family, and Virgil was forced to travel to Rome to negotiate his return. Luckily for Virgil, one of the officials gave him an introduction to the emperor; Not only was his land returned, but he also met Octavian's confidant Maecenas, who became Virgil's patron for the rest of his life. As a hard-working, meticulous writer. Virgil was not productive. In addition to the ten Ecloques, which apparently took at least five years to be published, Virgil wrote the four Georgics, which lasted seven years, and the Aeneid, his great masterpiece. Virgil worked at the Aeneid for eleven years until his death in 19 BC When he felt that the epic was still unfinished, he directed the destruction of the manuscript in his will. Fortunately for subsequent generations, the emperor, Virgil's most prominent friend and admirer, intervened to counteract this provision. He handed the manuscript over to two of Virgil's Virgil's and Tucca to edit only obvious errors and repetitions without adding the text. The result of their work is the beautiful and brilliant Aeneid we have today. All Mendelbaum's five verses are: Chelmaxions; The Savantasse of Montparnasse; Journeyman; Leaves of absence; and A Song of Letterpress. Mandelbaum is co-editor of Robert Richardson Jr. of Three Centuries of American Poetry (Bantam Books) and, together with Yehuda Amichai, of the eight volumes of the JPS Jewish Poetry Series. After his Ph.D. in Columbia, he was a fellow of the Society of Fellows at Harvard. During his Ph.D. program in English at the Graduate Center of CUNY, he was a visiting professor at Washington University in St. Louis and at the universities of Houston, Denver, Colorado, and Purdue. He holds honorary doctorates from Notre Dame University, the University of Assino, and the University of Florence, on the occasion of the 735th birthday of Dante, the only translator to be honoured; In 2003 he was awarded the Italian Presidential Prize for Translation. He is now a professor of literary history at the University of Turin and W.R. Kenan professor of humanities at Wake Forest University.
