It is located 100 km north of Culiacán, the capital of Sinaloa. The town serves as the town seat of Salvador Alvarado and is the center of a region called valle del Évora, named after the River Évora. In 2020, the city has approximately 72,500 inhabitants. It is the fifth largest city in the state in population after Culiacán, Mazatlán, Los Mochis and Guasave respectively. Urban logo Urban logo consists of: Left upper part: Mount Mochomo and river Evora referring to its region Left bottom: the primary elements used in trade related to politics, social and cultural life Right peak: pacific railway line, which began communication on progress in this area Right bottom: chickpeas as the main product in the region along with cheese and wool.
