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Tac Visor is a small windshield visor that increases color recognition while preventing glare. Does it really work? This is my Tac Visor, by Bell and Howell, is a light-filtering windshield visor inspired by the face guards used by Air Force pilots. I found Tac Visor in a local store as seen on TV here in Las Vegas for \$19.99. Tac Visor Review When I saw the tac Visor advert at the end of 2017, two things immediately jumped on me: I had already seen something like this, and I was wondering how many Tac brand products were going to come out? Tac Visor is a day/night car visor that clips onto your existing visor. There are two signs, one for the day and the other for the night. You can easily flip any panel you want, or keep them both in an up position when they are not in use. Certainly, when I opened the Tac Visor, I installed it incorrectly will cause a distracting reflection that is probably not even safe to use while driving. But once installed correctly there is still a reflection, but not as distracting. As you can see in the video below, I took Tac Visor for morning, afternoon and night tests. I was quite happy with the day panel because it basically worked the same as a pair of polarized sunglasses. And yes, it is polarized, as they prove with the inclusion of a special card. The day sign could be useful for those who wear prescription glasses, but do not have prescription sunglasses. Sponsored links I'm less impressed with the night sign because it did seem to provide a yellow hue with little difference in glare. I even compared it to Tac Glasses Night Vision and Night View NV, which are both yellowtinted night goggles, and none of them impressed me much or seemed to provide a noticeable improvement on night glare. There are some drawbacks when using Tac Visor. As mentioned previously, there is still a slight reflection, even when installed correctly. I have found that if you tilt the panel slightly, it seems to decrease the reflection. If you have a brightly colored shirt, however, you can still see it reflected in the Tac Visor. Another minor problem is that it seems to pick up fingerprints quite easily. Consider that every time you use it, your fingers touch touch Panel. The side of the day sign facing you is mirrored and seems inclined to preserve fingerprints. If you look at the Tac Visor on the website or advertising, the design looks different from the version sold in stores. My hypothesis is that a prototype was used to film promotional material, but the final version was modified for production reasons. In fact, the final version of Tac Visor looks more closely like the hd vision visor than the Tac visor shown in the ads. HD Vision Visor was a very similar day/night car visor that announced several years ago. Below you can see my full review of Tac Visor. August 2018 update: After using Tac Visor in the sun and heat of Las Vegas, it eventually deformed considerably to the point of being unusable. I do not recommend leaving this exposed to high heat for long periods of time. Alternatives As mentioned, HD Vision Visor was a very similar product around 2014 and can still be found on Amazon for about \$12.
