Position: Guard Michael Jordan may be the best player he's ever lived with. His career scoring average is the highest in NBA history. He won one championship, two Olympic gold medals and six NBA titles. He earned 10 NBA scoring crowns, the most ever. He had more moves in his offensive repertoire than anyone else. Without a doubt, he was the most popular player of all time, surpassing all others in endorsement income and public adulation. McDonald's named the sandwich - a McJordan burger - after it. His home state of North Carolina gave him a seven-kilometer stretch of I-40. He appeared on countless magazine covers and hosted Saturday Night Live. Jordan's game was characterized by high flying, tongue-waving dunks. He adopted the hang-time concept and developed it exponentially. However, it was far from one-dimensional. For the guard, he was a great rebounder and shot blocker. He led the league in intercepts three times and was called up to the all-defensive first team nine times. He was practically the perfect basketball player. Born on February 17, 1963, in Brooklyn, New York, Jordan grew up in Wilmington, North Carolina, where his father, James, worked for the General Electric Company and his mother, Deloris, worked at a bank. Michael stood out in sport. Baseball was his first love and the best sport of growing up. His childhood favorite memory was winning the MVP award when his Babe Ruth League team won the state championship. In basketball, he blossomed late, not as a sophomore, to make a varsity team at Laney High School. Feeling depressed, Jordan stepped up his basketball training and pushed into the starting lineup as a junior. The following year, he received a scholarship to the University of North Carolina. He averaged 13.5 points as a freshman and hit a game-winning shot against Georgetown in the NCAA championship game. In 1984, he won the Naismith and Wooden Awards as national footballer of the year. Pleased to have achieved his goals, Jordan left school a year earlier to try his luck in the NBA draft. The Houston Rockets, choosing the first, selected Hakeem Olajuwon. The Portland Trail Blazers followed Bowie himself. The Chicago Bulls got Michael and jordanaires. Jordan averaged 28.2 points and won the Rookie of the Year Award. At the start of his second season, Jordan suffered a broken foot, costing him 64 games. He returned to the playoffs in time and was sensational. In Game 1 of the best-of-five series against Boston, he had 49 points. In Game 2 he scored a playoff record of 63 points in a 135-131 double overtime loss. The Celtics, however, went on to sweep the series. In the 1986–87 season, Jordan averaged 37.1 points while the first player to score 50 or more points in three consecutive games. The following season, he won the first of his four most valuable player awards and became the first player in NBA history to win the title (35.0 PPG) and was named Defensive Player of the Year in the same season. Jordan was so good that the Detroit Pistons, Chicago's aigoing rivals, designed 13 defensive sets - The Jordan Rules - to deal with it. Detroit has recaptured the Bulls since the playoffs in 1988, 1989 and 1990, keeping Jordan in tears every time. He won the scorer's crown in 1989 and 1990, and during a point guard game in the spring of 1989, he had a triple-double in seven consecutive games. Jordan was particularly effective against the Cleveland Cavaliers. He averaged 45.2 points in the playoffs in 1988, a five-game franchise record. In 1989, his buzzer-beater in Game 5 eliminated the Cavs from the postseason. On March 20, 1990s, the Bulls surrounded Jordan with outstanding players such as Scottie Pippen and Horace Grant, jordan players called him a supporting cast and eventually won the championship. Two more quickly followed. The Bulls defeated the Los Angeles Lakers in 1993 - the first three-peat since the Boston Celtics won eight titles in a row between 1959 and 1966. Against the Lakers, Jordan averaged 31.2 points, 11.4 assists, 6.6 rebounds and 2.8 steals. Against the Blazers, he had 35 points and six 3-pointers in the first half of Game 1. He averaged 41.0 points against the Suns, the highest score in NBA Finals history. Jordan seemed to be at the peak of his abilities, but on October 6, 1993, saying that he no longer had the motivation to compete at his usual level, he announced the end of his career. He made his decision after a tragic summer in which his father was murdered in North Carolina. But while plotting his retirement, Jordan busy prepared for a new career in professional baseball. In 1994, he left for spring training with the Chicago White Sox before being sent to Birmingham, Alabama from the Double-A Southern League, where he struggled .202 with three home runs and 30 stolen bases. However, after a strike by major league players extended to 1995 spring training and Jordan was forced to cross the picket line to continue his career, he decided to move away from baseball. On March 18, 1995, he issued a twoword statement returning to the Bulls. Ten days later, he scored 55 points in a game at Madison Square Garden in New York. Jordan's usual sharpness, however, is lacking. His mistakes mounted and he had a dismal playoff performance, with the Bulls eliminated by Orlando in the East Semi final. Jordan promised better things for the 1995-1996 season, and he responded mightily. He won his record eighth scoring title (30.4); led the Bulls to a league-record 72 wins and another NBA title; he was the MVP of the regular season, All-Star Game and NBA Finals. Two more titles took place between 1996-1997 and 1997-1998, before Jordan withdrew from the NBA for the second time. Surprisinaly. Jordan attempted a third comeback at the age of 38, joining the Washington Wizards both on and off the dance floor (as a team board member) in the 2001-02 season. While many derided him for another comeback, he was a productive player, averaging more than 20 PPG over two seasons and retiring for the last time at the age of 40; his 31.5 PPG career scoring average still tops in history. Jordan remains close to the NBA. His experience in Washington failed, and Wizards owner Abe Pollin essentially fired Jordan as ceo. His Airness didn't start on buying the Milwaukee Bucks soon after, and he now owns a minority and general manager of the Charlotte Bobcats.
