Arduin is a fictional universe and fantasy role-playing system created in the mid-1970s by David A. Hargrave. It was probably the first cross genre of fantasy RPG, with everything from interstellar wars to horror and historical drama, although it was based mainly on the medieval fantasy genre. A brief history was one of the earliest challengers to TSR's Dungeons & Dragons. It started as a personal project Hargrave created to share with friends, but became so popular that he was inspired to publish the material. [1] Original Arduin set of supplements, dungeon modules, and a game assistive published, but were then produced by grimoire Games. Dragon Tree Press produced four more Arduin supplements before Arduin's rights and properties were purchased by the Emperor's choice of games and miniatures. Although Arduin's books don't explicitly claim to be dungeons & dragons supplement, they were considered such by most users. Black Grimoire All Dave Hargrave published RPG spells etc. Controversy and criticism of TSR's legal issue david hargrave was issued with a cease and desist order from TSR offices when it was found that the original publication of Arduin's books made direct references to the Dungeons & Dragons gaming system. The Hargrave method of handling the dispute was simply to use a white-out and write correction tape to mask the disputed references, and then the volumes were repeated in exactly that way. In some versions of Arduin print, these so-called fixes are clearly visible. Testimonials after their publication in 1979, White Dwarf magazine reviewer Don Turnbull gave the Trilogy a 4 out of 10 rating, stating he was distracted as to whether the book was supposed to be an addition to Dungeons & Dragons or a standalone game. [1] However, in later years, the RPGNet trilogy gave 6.72 out of 10. [2] Arduin mechanics There was also an assertion in the RPG world that the Arduin system lacked cohesion. It was only with the publication Arduin Adventure that a true standalone system began to evolve where other systems were not needed to properly manage the game. Much criticism was made of Hargrave's combat mechanics, to the point where many Game Masters simply used either their own versions or those in TSR. Greg Stafford and Chaos While David Hargrave was considered one of the best of the best Game Masters, he was also known for its somewhat volatile personality. The original Role Playing community was generally divided between love and only tolerance for Hargrave's passions, and his infamous set-out with Greg Stafford, resulting in Hargrave naming Arduin a spell after he took revenge, is one such example [3]. The spell was called Stafford's Star Bridge (Arduin Grimoire, Volume 1, Page 4): Stafford's Star Bridge is 9. Level Mage (Magic-User) spell. This creates a rainbow-hued bridge coruscating light that is 5 (1.52m) wide and 20 (6.1m) long on the level of the castor above the level required for use. The bridge will carry any weight and cannot be hit by non-magical things. The bridge can also be keyed to support any one type (or more), allowing all others to fall through selectively. Hargrave wrongly believed that Stafford had betrayed him over the Chaosium publishing business, thus being selective. According to Stafford, Hargrave was later very upset with himself that it had caused this spell and his behavior in this situation. The one-of-a-kind Arduin merchandise of Hargrave's death in 1988 left many Arduin items unpublished and incomplete. Some items, he on the whim of those he especially liked or was close to. Includes a Master Map area of about 100 miles square. This work was written by David his friend, writer Paul Mosher. It includes a lost island kingdom containing 136 villages/towns to cross the reference at Master Map, as well as 79 adventure area maps, 31 of which are keyed. Lancer's Rest Created October 1987. One of the last game-related issues posed by David A. Hargrave before his death in August 1988, Lancer's Rest was Lance Mazmanian's personal burial chamber, a very large one-level dungeon adventure that included the Hell Spiral and the 3,000 (914 meter) pool where Mazmanian's corpse was entombed. Created by Hargrave as a tongue-in-cheek tribute, the adventure itself was essentially in search of getting a life-extending treasure while avoiding Mazmanian's wandering avatar, a very powerful Lich-like entity that either attack or help the party sample percentage roll [4]. Illustrators (partial list) Several illustrators worked on Arduin materials at different times over the years, including the following: Erol Otus Phraint vs. Vroat (1979) by Erol Otus (from Howling Tower) First Printing By Grimduinoire (not least, The Arduin Trilogy, Vol. 1) included works of art by Erol Otus, an artist who later became known for his illustrations appearing and TSR's Dungeons & Dragons [5]. He drew many of the monster and artifact cards to several standalone dungeon modules, as well as painted box art (by airbrushing by Anthony Delgado) for the Grimoire Games Arduin Adventure. Brad Schenck Brad Schenck (a.k.a. Morno) contributed to the cover of Welcome to skull tower (AG II).
