Its name because Kingsnake eats rattlesnakes. Apparently kingsnakes are immune to or resistant to rattlesnake venom. Kingsnake also feeds on other snakes, lizards, amphibians, eggs of birds and birds, rodents. Rattlesnakes can identify king snakes by their smell. Rattlesnakes usually retreat in front of the Kingsnake, arching their backs and holding their heads and tails close to the ground while trying to hit the Kingsnake. Watch a three-minute Discovery Channel video of common Kingsnakes attacking and eating rattlesnakes: Kingsnakes are usually pityy, but when disturbed they can hiss, vibrate their tails and go on strike. If seized by predators such as coyotes, kingsneks can expel harmful musk. Kingsnakes come in a variety of patterns and colors. There is some controversy about the number of names and breeds. This is more confusing because some breeds can be crossed with others. I am using the naming convention of the Arizona Sonoran Desert Museum here. Most Kingsnek adults are 3-6 feet long. Below are photos of the most common breeds in the Southwest. All kingsnakes have a smooth scale, different from the gopher snake uplift scale. All Kingsnave are powerful constructors. Desert Kingsnek This black and white (or cream) is the most common kingsnak in the Tucson region. It is home to Arizona, New Mexico and Texas. It usually grows to 4 feet, but some are more than 6 feet long. This kingsnique usually produces up to 12 eggs that are delivered from March to June and incubated for 60 days. Hatches range in length from 8 to 10 inches. Common Kingsnek The common Kingsnek was called the California Kingsnak. It has alternating brown/black and white/cream in a band of yellow color. The adult range is 2.5-6 feet long. This snake occurs in much of Arizona, California and Baha California. The usual mating time is from May to August. Females produce as many as 24 eggs that hatch in 60 days. Hatching is 6-8 inches long and has a lighter color than parents. Sono ranking snake nora kingsnate is a deep chocolate brown that may usually look black in some lighting conditions. It occurs in southern Arizona and southern Mexico to Sinaloa. Young snakes may have white or yellow spots under their chins. This snake is generally 3-4 feet long and rather plump compared to other Kingsnakes. Mountain Kingsnake This cute snake is variously called Arizona Mountain Kingsnake or Sonoran Mountain Kingsnake, it may be 2.5 to 4 feet long. Have I seen this snake in the Bradshaw Mountains near Jerome? It may be confused with coral snakes, but it is much larger. Remember the rhyme: Red touch black, OK jack These snakes breed in the spring and generally produce 4-9 eggs.In this snake, the red band is much wider than the black and white/yellow bands. It can also be confused with coral snakes. The rest of the rhyme: in the red touch yellow, kill the fellow kingsnique, the red band is surrounded by a black band. Milk snakes are generally between 1.5 and 4.5 feet long. It occurs mainly in southern Sonora, but there are several specimens collected near the Little Colorado River in northern Arizona. This snake occurs mainly in forests and is mainly night-time. Breeding is similar to mountain kingsnade. I deal with snakes at the Arizona Sonoran Desert Museum, including all the Kingsnakes shown above. Kingsnake is my favorite snake. They look more curious than other snakes. When I have a snake and someone comes close, Kingsnake flicks his tongue to get a taste. By the way, taste is the most important sensation of snakes. Their forked tongues pick up particles in the air that are analyzed by Jacobson's organs on the roof of the mouth. The organ is so sensitive that it can distinguish the difference from both sides of the forked tongue. This gives the snake a sense of direction where the taste is coming from. Kingsneks have many pointed teeth to grab prey. Note that in the photo below, the snake has four rows of teeth on top. Also note that the teeth are very small. I've never been bitten, but the other docents have been. The teeth are so small that it's not a big deal. Besides the Western kingsnade mentioned above, some species, mostly black breeds, live in midwestern and eastern states. Eastern Kingsnakes eat copper heads as well as rattlesnakes. Be kind to the Kingsnade you will find in your garden. They help protect you from rattlesnakes and feed on rodents. The name is given to them referring to the smooth, enameled inverse scale. Their common name, Kingsnake, comes from the practice of kingsnake species in the range and form of other snakes (such as rattlesnakes) inhabiting the Americas from southeastern Canada to southern Ecuador. Some species vary greatly in size and coloring. Adult scarlet kingsnakes are usually 40-50 cm (16-20 inches) long, and common kingsnade can grow to 1.8 m (6 ft). Some kingsnakes are colored black with muted brown, while others are marked with lavender, white, red, yellow, gray, and lavender, which forms bright rings, longitudinal stripes, spots, and saddle-shaped bands. Behavior and diet kingsnakes use nods to kill prey and tend to be opportunistic in their diet. They eat other snakes (ofiophagy), including venomous snakes. They also feed on bald, rodent, bird and egg. Common snakes are known to be immune to the venom of other snakes and eat rattlesnakes, but it is not necessarily immune to snake venom from different areas. [6] The name king refers to preying on other snakes (as well as king cobras). Kingsnakes like The Kingsnake in California can exert twice the contracting power of rat snakes and pythons for their body size [scientists believe such strong coils may be an adaptation to the prey of snakes and other reptiles that can maintain low blood oxygen levels before suffocating.] [8] Most kingsnades have very vivid patterns in their skins. Some species, such as scarlet Kingsnakes, Mexican milk snakes and red milk snakes, have coloring and patterning that can be confused with highly toxic coral snakes. One of the rhymes of mnmonics to help people distinguish their non-toxic lookalikes in the United States from coral snakes is red to black, jack's friend. Red in yellow, kill the fellows. Other variations include Yellow red kills mates, black venom red is missing, [9][10] and references traffic light order Yellow, red, stop! All these mniesonics are Mikulous Flubius (eastern or common coral snake), Mikululas tenor (Texas coral snake), microlidi elyxanthus (Arizona coral snake) Applies only to three species of coral snakes. Coral snakes found in other parts of the world can have decidedly different patterns, have red bands that touch black bands, only have pink and blue bands, or have no bands at all.One source that gives full species status to a group of these snakes, which another source considers a subspecies group, is the opposite. For example, in the case of Lamperowellitis catalinensis, the classification is not necessarily finite because there is only one specimen. In addition, hybridization between species with overlapping geographic ranges is unusual and further confuses taxonists. Predator kingsneks are often preyed upon by large vertebrates, such as birds of prey. Tarantulas also sometimes go food them.
